The Struggle Against Fascism in Germany

First published in 1971, this reprinted edition consists of 24 articles by Leon Trotsky on the fascist movement in Germany, written from 1930-1932 (with one article from 1940), as he asserted all his powers of persuasion to stir the German workers to rise up against the fascists before they took power. Examines the class roots of fascism, the reasons it came to power, and advances a strategy to combat and defeat it.
