



Feather & Fan Scarf

Supplies: Vortextyarns Labyrinth (fingering weight, 434 yds/113 gr, Superwash Merino 60%/Bamboo 30%/Nylon 10%), 1 skein. Color shown: Saxifraga
Us Size 5 Needle

Gauge: 30 Stitches and 20 rows over 4 inches. Note: Gauge is not critical for this pattern, what you want is a solid but drapey fabric, so if needed, adjust your needle size according to those preferences rather than gauge.

Abbreviations:

K2tog – Knit 2 together

YO – Yarn over

Cast on 40 Stitches.

Row 1: Knit all stitches

Row 2: Purl all stitches

Row 3: Knit first 2 stitches; K2tog three times; (YO, K1) six times; k2tog six times; (YO, K1) six times; K2tog three times; Knit last 2 stitches.

Row 4: Knit all stitches.

Repeat Rows 1-4 until the scarf is the desired length, ending with Row 4, and binding off purlwise.

The sample scarf was 62 inches long and 5 inches wide after blocking, and used approximately one half of the skein.

The sample scarf was knit as described above. You may decrease or increase the width by subtracting or adding stitches in multiples of 18.
