




TOWEL BAR

10" C-C, 18" C-C or 24" C-C







INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- Mark Hardware Placement Use the installation template on the back of this brochure and a level to determine the desired hardware location. Mark hole positions based on the hardware's center-to-center specifications.
- 2 In Drywall Drill a pilot hole using a 3/8" drill bit. Insert the wall anchor into the hole and gently tap it into the wall until it's secure. Install the mounting bracket to the wall by inserting the wood screws into the wall anchors. Tighten the screws clockwise with a Phillips screwdriver until snug.

In Stud - Secure the mounting bracket to the wall with the provided wood screws. Tighten the screws clockwise with a Phillips screwdriver until snug. Repeat steps on the other side.





SPRING BAR








SWING ARM








CARE & CLEANING

For all care and cleaning, use a non-abrasive, lint-free, or microfiber cloth that won't scratch the hardware's finish. Regularly dust your hardware to maintain its appearance. If needed, clean with a slightly damp cloth and mild soap, then dry thoroughly. Designs with gemstones, lucite, or wood should be cleaned with a slightly damp, nonabrasive cloth and mild soapy water.

CHARACTERISTICS AND CARE OF LIVING FINISHES

Unlacquered Brass is a living finish that naturally develops a patina, creating a unique and beautifully aged look. This aging process is part of the finish's charm and will vary depending on humidity levels and frequency of use. If you prefer a brighter, more refined appearance, use a brass wadding polish according to the manufacturer's instructions. This will effortlessly restore the finish's original shine

while preserving the integrity of the metal.

CHARACTERISTICS AND CARE OF LACQUERED FINISHES

Polished brass, polished nickel, and burnished brass (for bath hardware only) are lacquered finishes and will not develop a patina over time. Clean using the general care instructions above.
