

## **Necklace Size Guide**

## 1. String, marker, and a ruler

Determine the length of a piece of string and cut it to match the desired necklace. Try it on around your neck to check where it fits; successfully layering requires finding the proper balance. Think about the pendant's size and shape. Repeat the procedure to examine how necklaces of various lengths may blend. Don't forget to check the length of the pendants and where they fall to achieve the desired appearance.

## 2. Existing necklace and a measuring tape/ruler

You may also measure a necklace or a chain you already have. Start with choosing the necklace that has the desired length. Place the necklace on a flat surface in a straight line and measure the necklace from one clasp end to the other. Make a note of the length. Don't forget to check the size of the pendants and add it to your measurement if the design you plan to buy has one.

 To utilize the measuring tape, set your printer setting to 100% scale and print the document on a A4 paper size.
