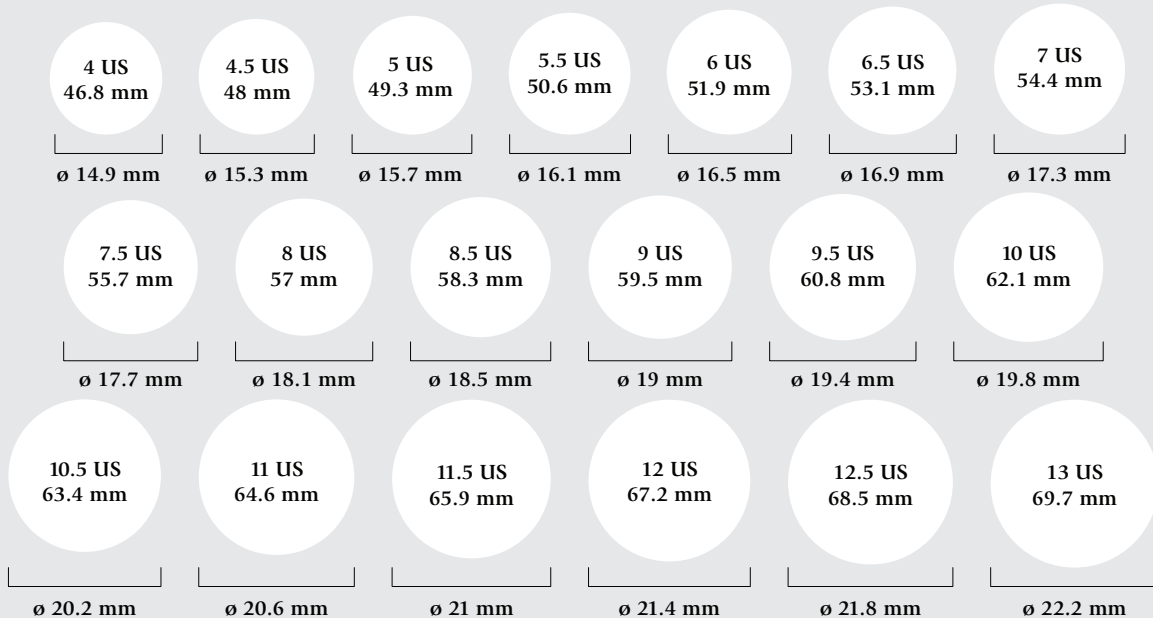
## Ring Size Guide:

Print on A4 paper, scaled to 100%. Make sure of the accuracy of the print by placing a credit card in the indicated area:



### Measure By Matching Your Ring:

To find your size, use a ring that fits you well. Match the inside of the ring with the circles below. Align your ring with the circle below that mostly closely matches in size. The inner edge of your ring should align with the outer edge of the circle. This number is the inside circumference of your ring. If your size falls between two circles, choose the larger size.

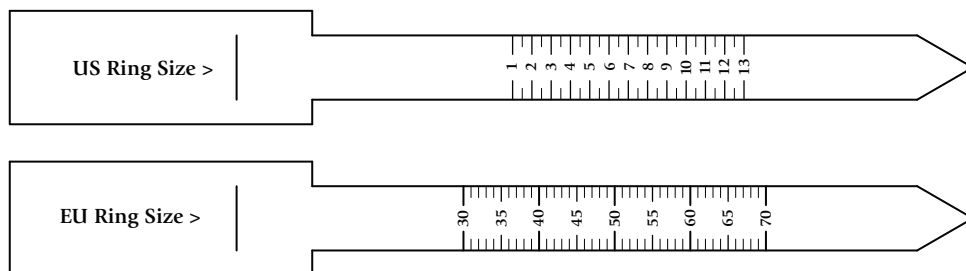


### Measure with the Rulers:

After you cut out the ruler, carefully cut the line to create a slit. Wrap the ruler around your finger at the base and pull the tapered end through the slit.

To make sure the ring will fit comfortably, we suggest also measuring your knuckle.

We recommend selecting a size that goes on and off your finger easily.



Ring size may also vary slightly depending on the style of the ring.  
Sizing availability is specific to each product.
