

TROUBLESHOOTING

Having some issues with your Blazing Bull? Try to resolve them with some of these troubleshooting solutions.

If you are still unable to resolve your issue,

PROBLEM	POSSIBLE CAUSE	SOLUTION
Burners do not ignite	Valve on propane tank is not open	Make sure valve on propane tank is fully open
	Regulator hose is squeezed, bent, or leaking Gas isn't getting to the burners	Check the hose routing and remove obstacles
	No spark occurs when pressing igniter button	Push and hold down the gas knob in the ON position when pressing igniter button
		Replace igniter battery
	Propane bottle is empty	Refill propane tank at an authorized LP gas dealer
Burner ignites but tiles appear to be more white than orange	Sunlight may affect the appearance of the burner tiles even though the unit is on and operating correctly	Wait 5 minutes for burners to heat up and continue normal usage
Burner tiles remain blue for over 5 minutes	Rain or water may have affected the burner	Allow unit to run for 15-20 minutes and continue usage
Burner extinguishes during operation appear to be more white than orange	Food has touched the safety shut off sensor	Turn unit off, shut off propane tank and lower grill grate. Wait 2-3 minutes, turn on propane tank and re-ignite
	Propane bottle is empty	Refill propane tank at an authorized LP gas dealer
Liner, drawer, or grill grate is stuck in unit	Unit was fired up without inserting all components	Turn off and allow unit to cool down before removing
