AMANDA AND DAVID'S TIPS FOR CREATING INDUSTRIAL-CHIC STYLE

Hit the lumberyard. For DIY projects, seek out raw materials like lumber and galvanized steel, which are at the heart of the industrial look.

Expose your hardware. People often go to great lengths to hide unsightly sockets and ductwork, but if you're after a fashionable warehouse look, conspicuous pipes can lend authenticity.

Introduce the unexpected. Use exterior elements such as ladders and barn or garage doors inside, and incorporate utilitarian pieces like a janitor's sink or wire racks to bring an edgy look to rooms.
