

RING SIZING GUIDE

Check first to ensure the most accurate measurement

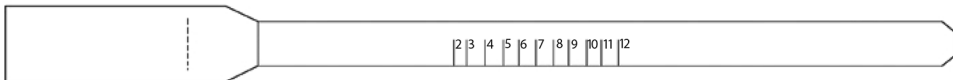

1. Make sure your printer settings are set to scale: NONE or print at 100%.
2. With a ruler, measure one of the solid black lines to the left in either cm or in.
3. If measurement is incorrect, please check printer settings to ensure you are printing at actual size.

METHOD 1 - PAPER SIZER

1. Carefully cut out the paper sizer below. Make a small slit along the dotted line to allow the ruler to pass through.
2. Feed the rounded end through the slit, with the numbers facing outwards.
3. Put the ring sizer over your finger and pull tight over the widest part, which is likely to be your knuckle.
4. Read the number next to the slit. This is your ring size.



TIPS:

Measure your finger later in the day when it is likely to be at its widest and avoid taking a measurement when your hands are cold, when your fingers are likely to be thinner than usual.

Reinforce the paper ring sizer by sticking a small piece of clear tape over the slit before cutting.

METHOD 2 - MEASURE AN EXISTING RING

1. Choose a ring that fits your desired finger
2. Place the ring over the circle below. Match the inside edge of the ring with the closest circle. This is the inside diameter of the ring.
