#### BEAR COMPOSITE BOW CONSTRUCTION

BEAR composite bow construction is not merely laminated construction, and the engineering problems involved are not new to us. Many years ago we learned that good bow design requires the use of woods or other materials having three distinctly different characteristics: the BACK has an extension or stretching job to do, and the belly or FACE calls for a material high in compression strength. Between the two is the CORE, the center of the bow known as the neutral area, whose chief function is to act as a spacer.

BEAR composite construction permits the use of different materials combined so as to release the desired characteristic of each and put it to much more effective use than has been possible up to now. Thus engineering skill and knowhow work together to produce beautiful, fast-shooting, durable bows. Recent developments in the field of high-strength glue bonds allow us to present these bows and the advantages they incorporate. They are released after exhaustive test, and like all our products are guaranteed both by our reputation as fine craftsmen and by our money-back policy.



### BEAR COMPOSITE BOWS



Bows are finished with a tough flexible varnish, hand rubbed to a dull luster. Strings are double loop and of the finest quality. An arrow rest is built into the bow. If you shoot left-handed be sure to specify this on your order.

In ordering a bow it is necessary that we know the draw length and weight desired. If you are not an experienced archer we will be glad to select the proper equipment. In order to do this properly we should know your height, weight and age, and whether you want the bow for hunting or for target shooting.

#### THE BEAR BOW QUIVER




Three years of testing under all kinds of conditions have resulted in this outstanding bow quiver. It is not a gadget in any sense of the word, but a very definite aid to the bunter who likes stillhunting and who knows the difficulty of going through the woods quietly with the conventional belt or back quivers.

Our tests have proven that one can shoot just as accurately with it on the bow as without it. Arrow heads fit into sponge rubber. Shaft is held by a rubber holder. Will take any style head, single, three and four blade, field, target and blunt points. Leather covered. Weight—6 ounces.

The bow quiver attaches to the bow by means of one screw in a threaded brass bushing permanently installed in the bow. It does not weaken or otherwise harm the bow, and can be removed or attached quickly.

Complete installation instructions accompany each Bow Quiver. If you prefer, we will do this work for a charge of \$1.50 plus






