Bear adds modern technology to the art of bowmaking



Here's a corner of Bear's modern laboratory where Bear physicists work with Bear bowyers in designing better bows for hunting, field and tournament shooting.

The introduction of Fiberglass-and-wood-laminated bow construction, pioneered by Bear in 1942, set sweeping new standards for performance. This type of construction has been the basis for practically all advancements made in bow design since that date, opening the door to a truly scientific approach to bowmaking. For the first time it was possible to work with materials with measurable and predictable characteristics.

Bear has developed the most modern research and testing laboratory in the industry. Three programs are conducted simultaneously. First is the basic research on bow design and performance to determine how best to continue to improve Bear Bows from year to year. Second, precision checking of production run bows so that quality is controlled

and remains constant. Third, material evaluation. The performance of a bow is highly dependent upon the material from which it is made. Bear has a continuing program to improve materials and has devised laboratory tests to evaluate how various materials will act in the bow.

High-speed Camera stops motion

In the foreground of the photo is Bear's ultra-high-speed camera, capable of taking 10,000 frames per second! It takes only seven-tenths of a second to start from a dead stop and run 100 feet of film through the camera. With this camera, studies of limb action, arrow flight—and even analysis of shooting technique—promise to add significantly to the precise understanding of bow function and performance.

Arrow velocity is measured accurately

The most precise instrumentation and techniques for measuring arrow velocity have been developed in the Bear laboratory. Since even slight variations in arrow speed significantly affect accuracy, it is necessary to be able to measure velocity with extreme precision.

Here, briefly, is how Bear tests a bow for velocity. An arrow is mechanically released and shot from the bow through a tube in which the arrow passes through two sheets of light which are a known distance apart. Light reflected from the arrow as it penetrates the first and then the second sheet of light is picked up by photo-multiplier tubes. The photo-multiplier has a response in the fractional micro-second (millionth of a second) area. The signals are then transmitted to an oscilloscope for reading and interpretation.

The oscilloscope is calibrated by using an extremely accurate time-mark generator which has a long term stability of three-hundredths of one percent. By mathematical computation from the oscilloscope readings, Bear technicians can accurately measure velocity within one-half of one percent, eliminating variables that make ordinary velocity tests largely meaningless.

Such exacting basic research will continue to bring Bear Bow owners the benefits of superior bow performance.

Take care of your bow . . .

While not in use, keep your bow unstrung. Hang it vertically or lay it across pegs supporting both limbs. Keep in a bow case in a cool, dry spot. When used in rain or snow, wipe dry before storing. In cold weather, flex bow several times to "warm it up". Occasionally, apply a light coat of furniture wax to protect finish.

Stringing your bow

Sketches and instructions at the right show how experts string a bow. For extremely heavy bows, a bow stringer such as the one on this page is a convenience and insures against accidents.

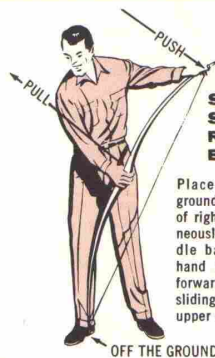


Brace Height

Measure at right angles to the string from the deepest cut in the handle on the face of the bow, below the arrow shelf.

The table gives brace heights as recommended by the designer. However, the proper brace height for you depends somewhat on your style of shooting. Since excessive brace height will rob you of some of the superior performance built into Bear Bows, brace your new bow at the lowest point that will give you:

1. Freedom from excessive wrist slap.
2. Minimum noise and vibration when shooting.
3. An arrow that does not wobble in flight.



Straight or Semi-Recurved Bows

Place lower tip off ground against inside of right foot. Simultaneously, pull bow handle back with right hand and push limb forward with left hand, sliding string loop into upper nock.

Recurved Bows

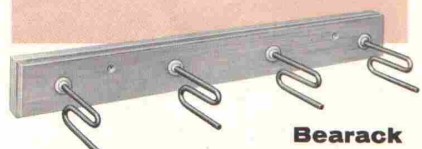
Place bow handle under thigh, lower tip across front of opposite ankle. Raise heel to keep tip off ground. Apply pressure against recurve, not bow tip. Slip upper loop into nock.

A protective cowl shields the sharp edges of broadheads or *Razorheads* and guards you against accidental injury. Points fit safely and snugly in a soft sponge rubber block. The open metal frame is sound-proofed with a vinyl coating. Arrow shaft clips into a molded rubber holder which keeps shafts separated to protect fletching. Two models, Screw-On and Tape-On, fit any bow; quickly and easily attached or removed.

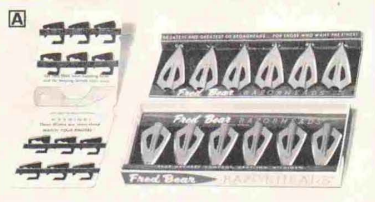
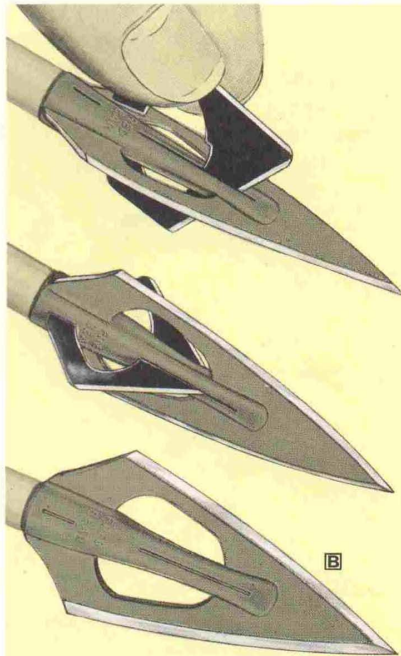

No game species in North America has proven too big or too tough for *Razorhead*. In fact, since its introduction in 1956 more big game trophies have been taken with *Razorhead* than with any other broadhead. Designed by Fred Bear for more humane sport and greater bowhunting success.

Razorhead is two blades in one. The large blade is mill-tempered steel, sharpened to a long, keen bevel. Its ferrule is slotted to receive a thin razor-steel pre-sharpened auxiliary blade, which can be replaced in the field in seconds.

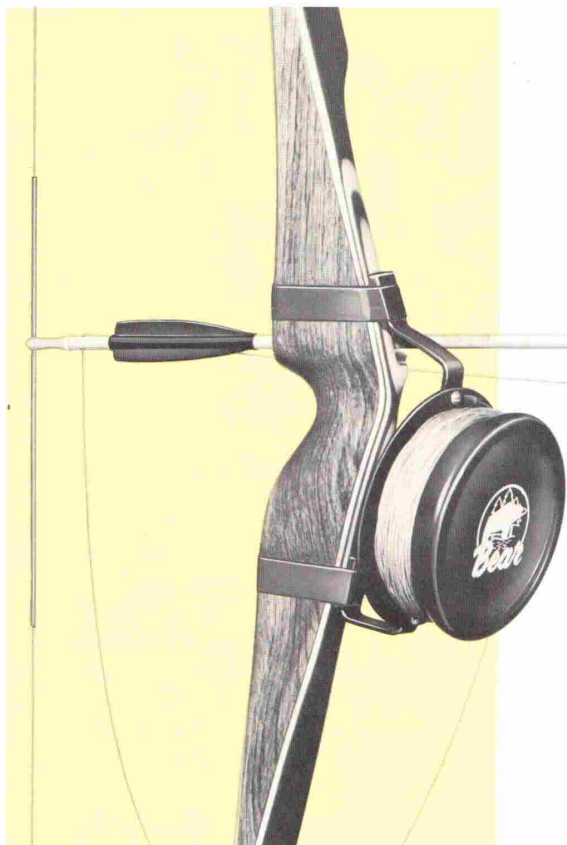

Great Off-Season Sport

There's no limit on action when you shoot rough fish with bow-and-arrow. It is good conservation and a lot of extra archery fun for you. (Be sure to check your local game regulations.)



Actually, bowfishing provides many more game shots per hour than does the average deer hunt. That's one reason it's becoming so popular.

Near fresh water you can go after carp, suckers, buffalo, gar and dogfish. They present terrific targets when they're basking in the sun-warmed shallows on a spring or summer day. Down south, "shining" gar at night is popular in the bayous. Salt-water sportsmen can pit their skill against skates, rays and small sharks.

It's easy to rig your bow with a simple low-cost Bear Bowfishing Outfit. The lightweight stationary reel uses the spinning concept. The spool is 4 3/4" diameter and accommodates fifty feet of 90 lb. test Nylon line.

The Bear GUARANTEE

Every Bear Bow is numbered and accompanied by a registration card which must be filled out and mailed by the purchaser or his Bear Dealer within 10 days after date of purchase. Should failure occur in a bow so registered within a period of 6 months after date of purchase, the Bear Archery Company will make free repair, or replacement if repair is not feasible, unless the bow shows evidence of mis-use or improper handling. Claimant must be the original owner and bow serial number must be intact.

Note: Adhesive tapes "cure" with age. We cannot be responsible for bow damage caused by tape.

After 6 months and up to 1 year after the purchase date, and provided the bow has not been mis-used or mis-

handled, repair or replacement will be made for 25% of the list purchase price. From 1 year to 1½ years after purchase date, the charge will be 50% of the purchase price. From 1½ years to 2 years the charge will be 75% of the purchase price. From 2 years to 3 years the charge will be 90% of the purchase price.

No adjustment will be made until the damaged bow is returned to the factory for inspection. Replacement will be made with a bow of the same model and weight, as near as possible. This guarantee is valid only when purchase has been made through an Authorized Bear Dealer. Dealers are not authorized to make adjustments, but will be glad to handle the shipping and correspondence.

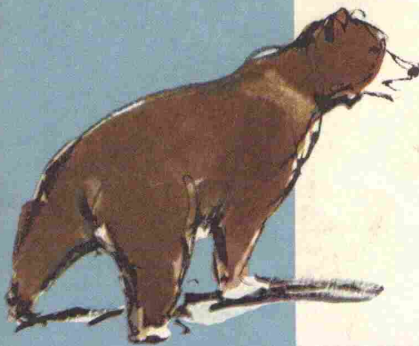
