And with the optional chrome-plated yokes and clamps, they will be the talk of archery.

Of course, there's still the perfect bow. The Fred Bear Custom Model Take-Down. This is the

bow that Vic Berger used to shatter the record books with back-to-back perfect games. The bow made of fantastic Futurewood. Twice as strong as natural wood, perhaps even more beautiful. And now redesigned for more record breaking performances. New radial feathered sight window and a new type of adjustable arrow plate—the Berger Button—that lets you dial in your center shot like the lens adjustment on a fine camera.

And all take downs are fitted with Fascor-Powered limbs for speed and stability. They're fiberglass laminated on both sides, triple reinforced at the tips with Bearglas. In three different lengths, interchangeable on all take-down handles (Check the following pages for details on the Bear Take-Downs)

Every 1971 Bear composite and Take-Down Bow (except the Bearcat and Little Bear) is equipped with the Converta-Accessory Insert Bushing. It provides for quick and easy installation of five bow accessories.

1. Bear Omni-Coupler and Stabilizer. (See page 31.)
2. Bear Hunting Stabilizer (See page 31.)
3. New Fred Bear Converta-Quivers. Both an 8-arrow and a 4-arrow bow quiver can be attached to the Converta-Accessory Insert by means of a special conversion bracket. (No bracket needed on Take-Down bows.) Fits any size bow from 48" to 72". (Details on page 29.)
4. Fred Bear Converta-Bowfishing Reel. Now, a fish reel that screws directly into the Converta-Accessory Insert. Put on or remove in seconds. (See page 28.)



5. Converter Insert. A special insert bushing is available that changes most any bow's 1/4" stabilizer socket instantly to 3/16", to accommodate any Bear Converta accessory.

Next, you put your arrows together.

And you can do just that, no matter what type of shaft you prefer. Bear introduces the "Plus 3" Converta-Point Arrows in aluminum, fiberglass and wood.

Make one dozen arrows do the work of three. Select your shaft material, spine and weight. Then interchange points for whatever shooting occasion arises—blunts, field points or Razorheads.

What's more, your present (or new) cedar arrows can be quickly converted to interchangeable "Plus 3" Converta-Points by installing the new WACA-wooden arrow converta-point adapter. The WACA easily converts any 1/8" cedar arrow to "Plus 3" Converta-Points. (Check all the new arrows beginning on page 20.)

The Take-Down Bow Limbs

One of the big differences between the Bear Take-Down bows and any other take-apart bows are the limbs. Both in how they're made and how they fit.

Only Bear limbs are Fascor® powered. The exclusive dark core material forms the heart of the laminated Bearglas® limbs. Each pair is perfectly balanced and

matched to perform as a unit. They perform perfectly because once locked into place in the handle section, they cannot rattle or move. Bear limbs are the only take-down limbs having keyway alignment. Machined grooves in the limbs and matching limb microgroove alignment key in the handle's socket, hold the limbs securely in place for perfect fit and alignment each time.

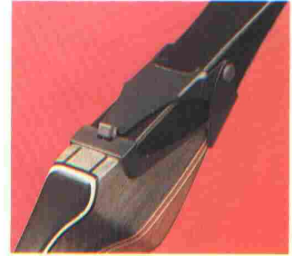

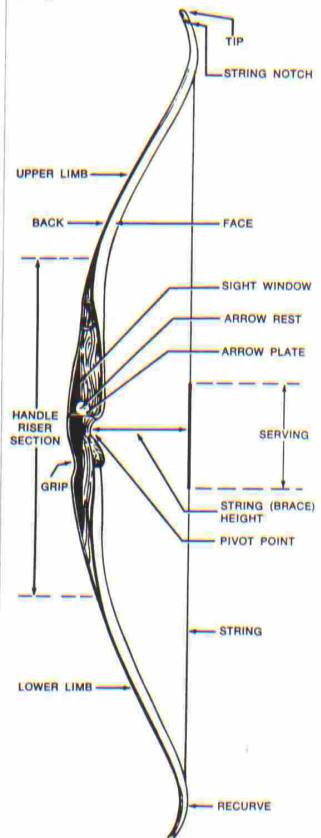

Guideline to Purchasing Field and Target Equipment

ARROWS: It is important that your arrows match your bow weight and draw length. The bow weight is marked on your bow. Your draw length can be determined quickly (see page 20). Use the best quality arrow you can afford. Bear Converta-Points are ideal since all the heads are interchangeable.

Aluminum: 1032—Field; 1033—Blunt;

Fiberglass: 1092—Field; 1093—Blunt; 1072—Field; 1073—Blunt;

Cedar: 1042—Field; 1043—Blunt;

QUIVERS: For field and hunting practice most hunters prefer a large center back quiver such as our Cheyenne (3175). Field and target shooters will like the convenience of the roomy Big Bear Back Quiver (3725) which holds up to 24 arrows and has a large zippered accessory pocket. Tournament and competition shooters will enjoy the lightweight Tournament Belt Quiver (3735) with divider strap and accessory pocket.

GLOVES: Most field shooters like a shooting glove such as our Master (3380) or the Corfam Pro-Glove (3360). Target and tournament shooters generally use a tab like the Bear Twin Tab (3330).

ARMGUARDS: An armguard is necessary not only to protect your forearm from string slap, but also to keep sleeves from deflecting the string. One of the most popular guards used by all types of archers is the Ventilated Armguard (3465). However the brushed aluminum Pickering Armguard (3490) is cool, comfortable and used by many shooters. For those who like a longer armguard to protect above the elbow as well as below, we suggest the (3480) Hunting Armguard.

SIGHTS: Many archers demand the accuracy of a bowsight, and tournament shooters acclaim the Bear-Jeffery Omni-Bowsight (6300) as the best available. The Custom Model Tournament Handle Section of the Bear Take-Down, the HC-300 and the Tartar bow come factory drilled to receive this sight. The Tartar, as well as many earlier model Bear bows, is built to receive the Bear Premier Sight (6050). For details on installing these sights on other Bear bows, please write our Custom Department.

TARGETS: Several types and styles of targets are available to suit your individual requirements. See page 36 for a complete display.

ADDITIONAL EQUIPMENT: While there are many other items the archer will want to have, we offer the following initial suggestions to make your archery fun, easier, safer and more enjoyable.

Now your Bear dealer can help you get a personal bow that will be as unique as your own fingerprints. Our new Custom Bow Department is ready to modify factory-ordered Bear bows to your specifications. Most any modification that does not alter the basic design of the bow can be made, including:

1. Radial feathered sight window—to give you a deeper, more tunable center shot.
2. Custom grip—to fit your hand like a glove.
3. Custom tillering—special balancing of both upper and lower limbs for any shooting style.
4. Physical weight balancing—installation of stabilizer and bushings and reappportioning the mass static weight balance.



How to tune your bow

In tournament archery, as well as in bowhunting, your ability to hit your target or game boils down to two factors. Your bow and your arrow.

Sound basic and fundamental? Well, that's what archery is. A sport of fundamentals. Master them and you'll be a top shooter.

Sure, it takes a great deal of time practicing your draw, anchor and release; hours of perfecting your aim and concentration. But none of it will do you any good unless your bow and your arrows are matched perfectly to each other and to you, the archer.

The biggest mistake most people make in selecting a bow, is choosing one with too much pull. This is particularly true of men. Pick a weight you can hold at full draw for ten seconds without quivering. Don't underestimate your strength, either. Once you've found a weight you're comfortable with and you're sure that any heavier load would be too difficult to hold, you're ready to select your arrows.

String Height is Important

Before you get your arrow, however, better check that bowstring. To measure brace height, measure at right angles to the string from the deepest cut in the handle on the face of the bow below the arrow shelf.

For example, if you have a 30" draw and you're shooting a 36 lb. bow, your bow weight is actually 40#. Similarly, if you have a 27" draw your 36# bow is only drawing 34#.

Using your actual bow weight at your draw length, consult your Bear Dealer. In a top quality aluminum arrow, such as the **1010** Bear Easton Arrows, you could have several different weights to choose from. Select your weight to arrow usage—indoor, field, or hunting.

The spine, or stiffness, of the arrow is also very important in proper selection. For example, an arrow that is of improper spine for your bow can shoot either right or left of target.

The spine of an arrow is the measured deflection, in inches, of the shaft when depressed by a two pound weight at its center. This flexibility, and its variation in various weights, is how arrows are matched to different weighted bows. Here again, your Bear dealer will help you match the proper spine and weight to your draw weight and length. With the proper spine, it is the weight of the arrow shaft that is the determining factor in arrow speed and trajectory.

Once you have your arrows and accessories perfectly matched to your bow and to yourself, you must be their equal. Concentrate on the same draw, anchor, smooth release, and you'll be heading toward that perfect 300 score or that prize buck trophy!

Caution

Some people still use the "push-pull" or the "step-through" methods of stringing a bow. We do not suggest either of these methods, since damage to the bow limbs or injury to the user is a distinct possibility. Instead, we recommend the use of a bow stringing device such as our "Three-Bear Bowstringer" (Catalog No. 7850)

bevel. Finish up by holding the file flat on the bevel at a 90° angle to arrow shaft and take five or six light strokes on both sides of edge. This has the same effect as a butcher's steel in removing burr for best final cutting surface. Do not file main blade to long slender point. A rounded, chisel point (see illustration) will prevent it from curling when striking hard bone.

Bear guarantee

Every Bear Bow is numbered and accompanied by a registration card which must be filled out and mailed by the purchaser or his Bear Dealer within 10 days after date of purchase.

Should failure occur in a bow so registered within a period of 9 months after



Choosing the Proper Arrow

Selecting the proper length for your arrow is easily done. Using a special measuring arrow that's marked off in inches, take up your full draw. Your correct arrow length is the point at which the arrow stops in relation to the front of the arrow shelf. (See illustration on page 24.)

Now that you know your draw length, you must match it to the weight of your bow. Most bows are weighted at 28". For each inch difference in draw length, add or subtract approximately two pounds of bow weight from the weight marked on the bow.

Once you have all these factors matched up—bow, draw length, actual draw weight, spine and weight of the arrows—you must make sure they are kept consistent. This is what we mean by matched arrows. Each shaft is accurately weighted, with the proper wall thickness and the correct spine. In highest quality arrows, these tolerances are amazingly close. As you get into less expensive arrows, you have to allow for some variations.

Your own shooting situations will determine your arrow selection. If you are serious about winning in tournament archery, you can't afford to settle for less than the finest. (You can't do better than the **1010** Bear-Easton aluminum Arrows.) For intermediate archers and beginners, the Bear Falcon **1150** or **1060** Cedar arrows will serve you well.

Choosing the Right Accessories

There are many accessories which can be added to your bow to make you a consistent archer. Hunters and tournament shooters alike, can add sights, stabilizers, and a variety of other devices to their bows.

Simply stand on the cord after attaching the Bow stringer to your bow tips. The tips bend as you pull up—ready for easy, safe stringing. Why take a chance on twisting your bow limbs and ruining your bow or injuring yourself? Use the bowstringer used by the pros. For more information see page 25.



Tips on sharpening your Bear Razorheads®

Razorheads are factory-sharpened, but its very important that your Razorheads be sharpened before hunting—see instructions on your Razorhead package. Use a mill file such as our **3135** or Bear's **7255** Cutmaster Sharpener. File toward the point and at the original

date of purchase, the Bear Archery Company will make free repair, or replacement if repair is not feasible, unless the bow shows evidence of misuse or improper handling, or limb damage due to improper stringing.

After 9 months and up to 18 months after the purchase date, repair or replacement will be made for 1/3 of the purchase price.

After 18 months to 36 months after purchase date, repair or replacement will be made for 2/3 of purchase price.

No adjustment will be made until the damaged bow is returned to our factory for inspection. Replacement will be made with a bow of the same model and weight, as near as possible.

This guarantee is valid only when purchase has been made through an Authorized Bear Dealer. Dealers are not authorized to make adjustments.

REPLACEMENT WILL BE MADE BY FACTORY CUSTOMER SERVICE DEPT. ONLY.

This warranty is transferable from one owner to another, provided bow is registered at time of purchase by original owner.

Special Warranty Notice

The handle sections of the Bear Take-Down bows have a special five year full replacement or repair warranty, providing the normal requirements in the standard Bear guarantee are met. (See above.)

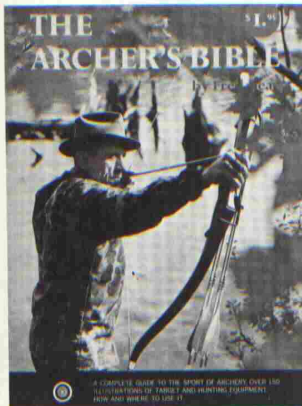
The Take-Down limbs carry the same generous three-year guarantee which accompanies all Bear bows. However,

limb replacements will be made in pairs only. Since each pair of limbs is a matched set, single limbs cannot be supplied.
