Compound Bow Draw-Force Curve Showing Comparison of 30 and 50% Let-off



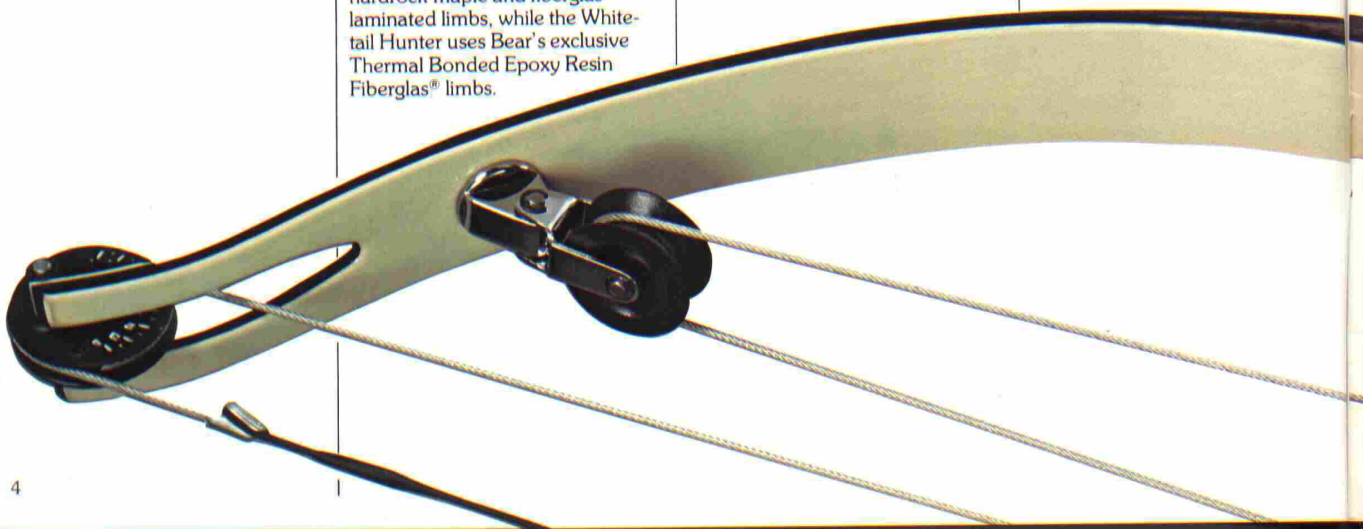

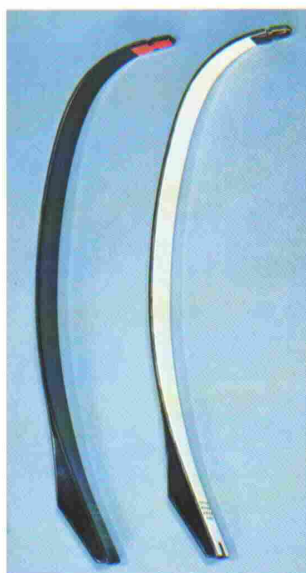

Archery Safety

- Shoot only at the target.
- Never shoot up into the air or in any direction where you might destroy property or endanger life.
- Never draw or shoot your bow when anyone is between you and your target.
- Always be sure that the area back of your target is clear.
- Never allow anyone to retrieve arrows until all arrows have been shot.
- Be sure arrows are of the correct length and stiffness for your bow.
- If an arrow has even a small crack, throw it away immediately.
- An archery set is not a toy! Treat it with respect.

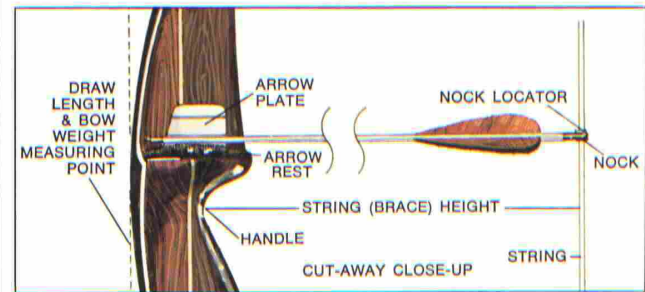

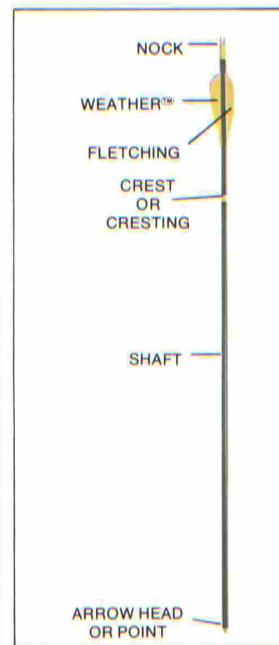
How to select correct arrow length:



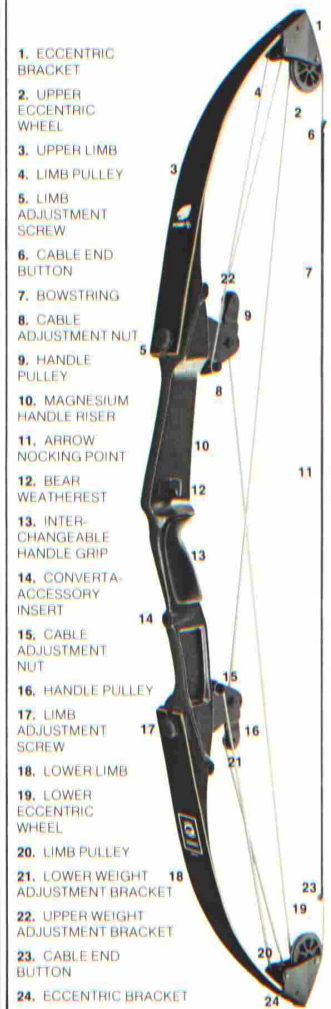
First method. Hold yardstick at center of chest as shown. Your draw is measurement at fingertips.

Second method. Draw a measuring arrow (marked in inches) in your bow. At full draw, your correct arrow length stops at the front of the arrow shelf.

The length of the arrow measures from bottom of nock slot to the back of the head.



COMPOUND BOW TERMINOLOGY



How to Match Arrows & Bow Weight on Conventional Bows

Match your draw length to your bow weight. For each inch difference in draw length, add or subtract about two pounds of bow weight from the weight marked on your bow (most bows and all Bear bows are weighed at 28" (71.12 cm.)). Example: you have a 30" draw. You're shooting with a 36 lb. (16.20 kg.) bow. Your bow weight is actually 40 lbs. Similarly, if yours is a 27" (68.58 cm.) draw, your 36 (16.20 kg.) lb. bow is drawing only 34 lbs. (15.30 kg.) 45

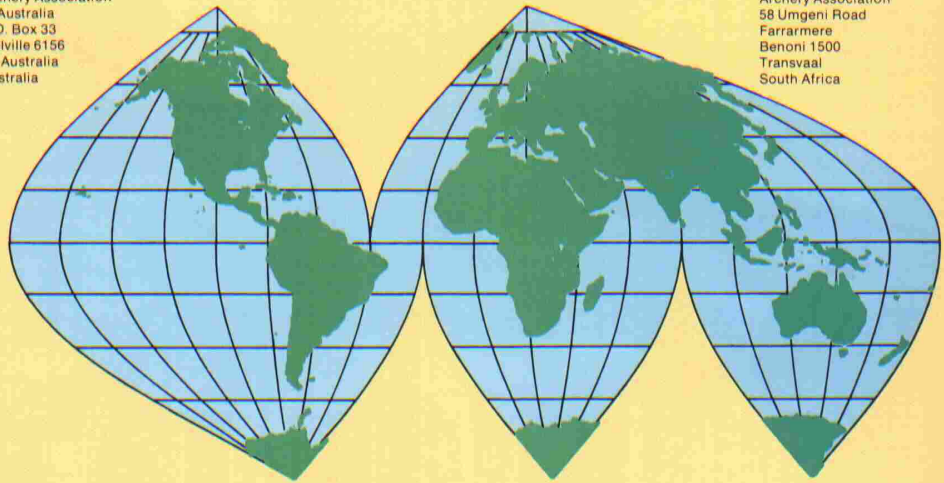

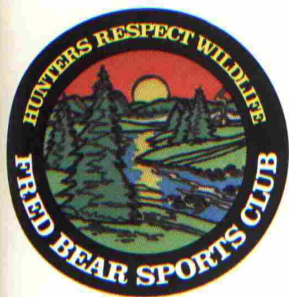

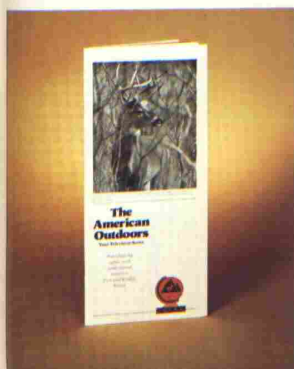

What it is and why you should join it.

1. The Fred Bear Sports Club is an international organization with over 20,000 members in all 50 states and 28 foreign countries. Its main purpose is to help keep the sports of hunting and fishing from being outlawed while at the same time providing archers with challenging and interesting awards and rounds, and a code of ethics to follow in the out-of-doors.

2. During the past year your Fred Bear Sports Club has been working hand-in-hand with the International Association of Fish and Wildlife Agencies (Washington, D.C.) in the planning, production, financing and publicity of the IAFWA's new television series THE AMERICAN OUTDOORS. The IAFWA is composed of the Directors of the 50 State Fish and Game Departments, the Dominion Government of Canada, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, Wildlife Agencies of the



United States Government and the Republic of Mexico. To date, The Fred Bear Sports Club has invested over \$100,000 in this project to help save your sports of hunting and fishing. This project is the fish and wildlife professional's answer to THE GUNS OF AUTUMN and similar Anti-Hunting programs. 3. There are six chairs on the new National Rifle Association (NRA) Archery and Bowhunting Committee in Washington, D.C. Your Fred Bear Sports Club sits in one of those chairs, representing bowhunter's best interests and viewpoints to our friends in the NRA, and to influentials in our nation's Capitol.

4. Pro-Bowhunting and Hunting publicity is sent regularly to the 1800 members of the Outdoor Writers Association of America. During the past year more than 25,000 pieces of mail went out to help support bowhunting on your local level.

5. Anti-Hunting and Anti-Fishing materials are regularly sent by The Fred Bear Sports Club to all Archery Lanes (ALOA), Archery Manufacturer's Organization (AMO) members, Fishing Tackle Manufacturers, American Archery Council (AAC), NRA Bowhunting Committee and others to keep them informed of the well-financed and highly active "Anti-Movement" in America today.

6. During the past few years, we have donated funds to active pro-hunting groups in America, including the National Society for Conservation and Animal Protection (the folks most active in the courts fighting the Anti-Hunters) and the AAC Bowhunting Defense Fund.

7. We are currently helping some of our overseas members establish Bowhunting Seasons in countries where it is not now permitted. Two such countries currently being aided by FBSC are France and Yugoslavia.

8. You will be able to participate in three (3) awards programs. The Bowhunting Division (for game shown), the Field Division (awards for three levels of proficiency indicated) and the Indoor Bowhunter's Round Awards at any ALOA (Archery Lane Operator's Association) Lanes. For name and address of the lanes nearest you write: ALOA, Dept. BA, 1500 North Chatsworth St., St. Paul, Minn. 55117, Area Code 612-488-9888.

9. You will get state or local support from a nationally based bowhunting organization when requested.

10. Through the BIG SKY you will be made aware of pro-hunting and anti-hunting news from other states. We also cooperate on significant ecological news items such as the Cache River Duck Flyway Controversy.

11. Through the national advertising that The Fred Bear Sports Club does we are attempting to educate the general public on the contributions of sportsmen to proper wildlife management and good conservation.

12. The FBSC Field Round and ALOA/FBSC Indoor Bowhunter's Round are designed to give the bowhunting fraternity its first national proficiency base. Informed sources indicate that in the very near future bowhunter education tests will probably be mandatory.

13. The FBSC serves as a national clearing-house on anti-hunting information.

14. A part of your \$5 Membership fee is used to disseminate information regarding the unfair and malicious attacks by the Anti-Hunting groups on hunting in general (many of our members hunt with both rifle and bow) and bowhunting in particular. For example, to date we have distributed over a million of our Bear Facts cards to both the general public and to State Fish and Game Departments at their request, for distribution to their staffs. In addition we send our quarterly, THE BIG SKY, to state governors, all U.S. Congressmen, State Departments of Natural Resources, influential press, and selected legislators in many of the states. As a member of the Fred Bear Sports Club you will receive THE BIG SKY.

15. When accepted for membership, you will receive the Member's patch, at no additional charge, along with a Member's bow decal, window bow-case decal, certificate, membership card, a one year's subscription to THE BIG SKY and the initial award patch in each of the three (3) programs when you qualify.

Fred Bear Sports Club Objectives

The Fred Bear Sports Club has as its goals those of saving the sports of hunting and fishing from being outlawed, the protection of our outdoor ecology and the proper wildlife management of the woods, fields and waters of this great land. natural resources and the honest fulfillment of the restrictions under which they compete in all outdoor sports.

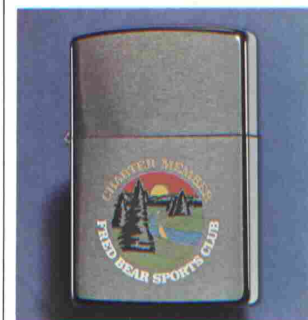
