TEAM BEAR

Your chance to get in on all the fun . . .

Our newly introduced Team Bear Program is designed to provide the archer using Bear equipment with a sense of identity and to recognize up-and-coming archers on the local level who are shooting Bear products. The program is a direct result of Fred Bear's and Bear Archery's commitment to promote our sport and to encourage participation in local, regional and national archery shoots.

You can participate in Team Bear and win. Team Bear shoots will be held all over the country and will be advertised in major archery publications and tournament promotions. Registration for Team Bear at any meet where it is being held is in addition to the normal shoot. It costs nothing to sign up and the only requirement is that you shoot a Bear bow. Any shooter registered, except members of Pro-Team Bear will be eligible for the awards.

Local shoots will pay \$100 in silver dollars for the highest scratch score and prizes of \$50 and \$25 will be awarded under the "Lewis System" handicap. Prizes will be awarded in both Men's and Women's Divisions. NFAA Sectional Shoots will be the same except cash awards will be \$200, \$100 and \$50 and Major National Shoots will pay \$400, \$200 and \$100.

In addition to cash awards paid in silver dollars, winners will also receive Team Bear shooting shirts and jackets. And at the end of the year a Team Bear Grand Champion will be chosen on the basis of a points system — one for the Men's division and one for the Women's. The winners will be awarded a specially engraved bow of their choice autographed by Fred Bear.

So practice with your bow, put on your colors, and when attending shoots this year look for the Team Bear Headquarters banner and register. We'll be looking for you.

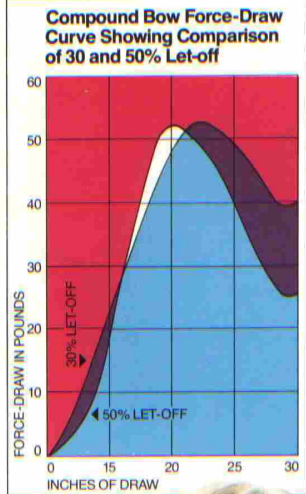
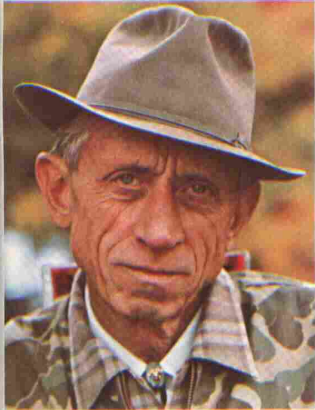

Bear Compound bows allow you to hold longer at full draw, for the best shot and to shoot for an extended period of time with less muscle fatigue. This is true because, unlike the conventional bow which increases in weight as you draw back the string, the Compound bow reaches it's heaviest draw, or *peak weight*, shortly after you start to pull back the string and then relaxes to much lighter weight to hold at full draw.



The difference between peak weight of a Compound and the lower weight you hold at full draw, called *relaxed weight*, is a function of the eccentric wheels. Bear uses wheels designed to provide let-off of approximately 30 or 50% less than peak weight. Bows with a smaller degree of let-off store more energy than identical bows with a larger percent of let-off—at the expense of your having to hold more weight at full draw.

Therefore, Bear offers you bow choices—30% let-off for an extra few feet per second in arrow travel or 50% let-off for ease of holding at full draw for a longer period of time.

Bear Compounds come in two and six wheel styles. The two wheeler is the simplest design and requires no tuning or adjustment from the user. The Bear Kodiak Special® and the Bear Blacktail Hunter™ fit into this category. The six wheel design provides for an almost infinite degree of tuning adjustment for your style of shooting and a greater degree of peak

weight adjustment—up to 25 lbs./ 11.25 kg. In general, they also have slightly faster arrow flight than two wheelers. Bear Tamerlane II's®, Alaskan®, Bear Polar LTD®, Temujin II® and Whitetail Hunter® are all of 6 wheel design.

Bear also offers two choices in limb design—Fiberglass® and laminated. Bear's finest bows feature a laminated limb made of Fiberglass® and hardrock maple for the most effective working limbs yet devised. Our thermal bonded Epoxy Resin Fiberglass® limbs are the best in the industry—smooth, fast and long lasting. The choice is yours, and you can't go wrong either way.

All Bear Compounds feature magnesium alloy handles for strength, centralized mass and durability. Many other materials have been tried, but none have matched the all-around durability of the magnesium handle.

The entire design of Fred Bear's Compounds has been carefully engineered and only the best materials are used. Our cables are plastic coated steel aircraft cables and the eccentric wheels on our finest Compounds feature needle roller bearings like those used on automobiles. Our bows are designed to shoot for years. And our Research & Development staff is constantly at work testing and improving our products.

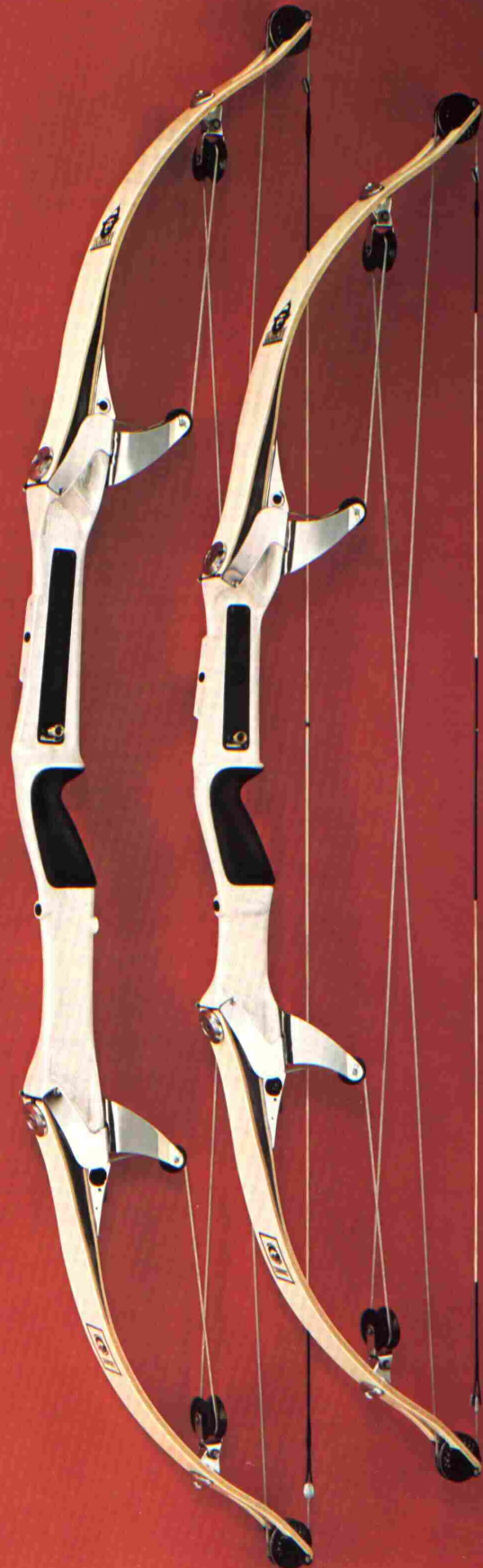

Irvine, California—In a special match race, an arrow from Texan David Hughes, bow-raced and beat Gary Deck's 2,500 horsepower AA/Fuel Dragster from 0 to 60 M.P.H. In general, equal weight arrows fly from a Compound bow about 10% faster than from a conventional recurve bow of the same weight. The Compound's primary advantage is the lower weight at full draw, allowing you to hold longer to take your best shot.

Our arrows are made of either aluminum, fiberglass or cedar and all of our best arrows feature Weathers™, Bear's exclusive injection molded plastic fletching that is weather-proof, stable and has a rapid recovery rate.

How to select the correct arrow length

Arrow length is marked on each package of arrows and that figure is the length of the arrow measured from the bottom of the nock slot to the back of the head. To find what length arrow you draw, try one of the two methods listed below.



First method. Hold yardstick at center of chest as shown. Your draw is measurement at fingertips.

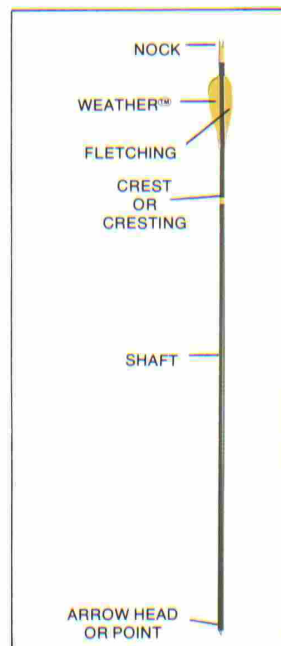
Second method. Draw a measuring arrow (marked in inches) in your bow. At full draw, your correct arrow length stops at the front of the arrow shelf.

How to match arrows and bow weight on Compound bows

Due to the Compound's release weight, a variety of arrow sizes can be shot out of a Compound. For hunting, Bear recommends that you use your bow's peak weight as the figure with which to match your arrow weight. This weight will provide for the higher degree of energy on delivery. Using peak weight is also a good starting point for target or field shooting, but you may wish to experiment for the perfect spine for your bow, your type of release and your shooting style.

How to match arrows and bow weight on Recurve bows

Match your draw length to your bow weight. For each inch over 28" (71.12 cm.) draw add 2 lbs. (5.08 kg.) to the weight required and for each inch under 28" (71.12 cm.) draw subtract 2 lbs. (5.08 kg.) from the weight required.

ARCHERY SAFETY

- Shoot only at the target.
- Never shoot up into the air or in any direction where you might destroy property or endanger life.
- Never draw or shoot your bow when anyone is between you and your target.
- Always be sure that the area back of your target is clear.
- Never allow anyone to retrieve arrows until all arrows have been shot.
- Be sure arrows are of the correct length and stiffness for your bow.
- If an arrow has even a small crack, throw it away immediately.
- An archery set is not a toy! Treat it with respect.



Involvement in an organized archery program can help you to increase both your skill and enjoyment of the sport. Listed below are some of the many archery related programs available.

The Presidential Sports Award in Archery—is earned by shooting a minimum of 3,000 arrows (no more than 60 arrows in one day) at a minimum target distance of 15 yards. The qualifying standards of the Presidential Sports Award are designed to assure regularity of participation and an investment of time and effort conducive to physical fitness for those fifteen years or older. Further information, personal log books and qualifying standards are available free from: The Fred Bear Sports Club, Rural Route One, Grayling, MI 49738.

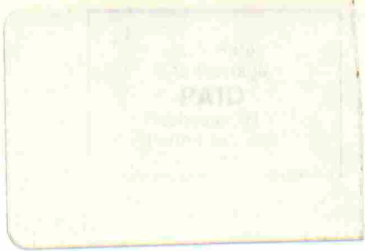
