## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted. WOF = Width of Fabric • LOF = Length of Fabric

## Pillow \#1

Fabric A (5343-78 10" Blocks - Patriotic):

- Fussy cut (1) $911 / 2$ " square, centered on a car scene.

Fabric B (1351-Chambray Just Color! - Chambray), cut:

- (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $11 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Fabric C (1351-Stone Just Color! - Stone), cut:

- (3) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips.

Fabric D (5342-88 Mini Stars - Red), cut:

- (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ x WOF strip.

Fabric E (5337-78 Tire Track Stripe - Patriotic), cut: - (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip.

Fabric F (5335-78 Spark Plugs - Patriotic), cut: - (1) $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip, sub-cut (4) $51 / 2 "$ squares.

Backing (5336-78 Tossed Muscle Cars - Patriotic), cut:

- (1) $14 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ WOF strip, sub-cut (2) $141 / 2 " \times 201 / 2 "$ strips.


## Pillow \#2

Fabric A (5343-78 10" Blocks - Patriotic):

- Fussy cut (1) 10 " square, centered on a car scene.

Fabric B (5337-78 Tire Track Stripe - Patriotic), cut:

- (1) 2 " x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) 2" x 10 " strips.
- (1) 2 " x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) 2" x 13 " strips.

Fabric C (5342-88 Mini Stars - Red cut:

- (1) 4" x WOF strip, sub-cut (4) 4" squares.
- (1) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " x 12 " strips.
- (1) $1 \frac{1}{4} 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip, sub-cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{4 \prime \prime} \times 131 / 2 "$ strips.

Fabric D (5341-77 Tone-on-Tone Car Parts - Navy), cut:

- (3) $13 / 4$ " x WOF strips, sub-cut (8) $13 / 4 "$ x 11 " strips.

Fabric E (1351-Stone Just Color! - Stone), cut:

- (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip, sub-cut (4) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- (1) $13 / 4$ " x WOF strip, sub-cut (8) $13 / 4$ " x 3 " strips.

Fabric F (5342-11 Mini Stars - Light Blue), cut:

- (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ x WOF strip, sub-cut (8) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $41 / 2 "$ strips.

Backing (5338-78 Furry Dice - Patriotic), cut:

- (1) $14 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip, sub-cut (2) $14 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $201 / 2$ " strips.

Pillow \#3
Fabric A (5334-78 On-Coming Cars - Patriotic), cut: - (1) $241 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2$ " WOF strip.

Fabric B (1351-Stone Just Color! - Stone), cut:

- (4) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ x $24 \frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.

Fabric C (5341-77 Tone-on-Tone Car Parts - Navy), cut:

- (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ x $24 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ " WOF strips.

Fabric D (5333-78 Garage Collage - Patriotic), cut: - (1) $24 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) $24 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $61 / 2 "$ strips.

Backing (5342-77 Mini Stars - Navy), cut:

- (2) $16 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $241 / 2$ " WOF strips.


## Pillow \#4

Fabric A (5333-78 Garage Collage - Patriotic), cut:

- (1) $97 / 8 "$ x WOF strip, sub-cut (4) $97 / 8$ " squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (8) $97 / 8$ " triangles.

Fabric B (1351-Stone Just Color! - Stone), cut:

- (2) $37 / 8$ " x WOF strips, sub-cut (12) $37 / 8$ " squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (24) $37 / 8$ " triangles.

Fabric C (5342-88 Mini Stars - Red), cut:

- (1) $31 / 2$ " x WOF strip, sub-cut (8) $31 / 2$ " squares.

Fabric D (5338-78 Furry Dice - Patriotic) cut: - (1) $31 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip, sub-cut (8) $31 / 2$ " squares.

Backing (5336-78 Tossed Muscle Cars - Patriotic), cut:
-(2) $16 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 241 / 2$ " WOF strips.

Sew using a $1 \nmid 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Always press towards the darker fabric while assembling, unless otherwise noted by the arrows.

## Pillow Assembly

## Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the direction of the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

## Pillow \#1 Assembly

1. Sew $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 9 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the $91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A square. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ " $111 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square. Trim the block to measure $101 / \mathbf{2}^{\prime \prime}$ square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 1).
2. Sew together (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF Fabric C strip, (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric E strip, (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric C strip, (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric D strip and (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric C strip, lengthwise and in that order from left to right, to make (1) Strip Set. Cut the strip set into (4) $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 101 / 2 "$ Unit 2 strips (Fig. 2).
3. Sew (1) $5 \underline{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F square to each end of (1) Unit 2 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 2 strip to each side of the Unit 1 square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together to make the Pillow \#1 top.
4. Turn under the $201 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ edge of (1) $14 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $20 \frac{1}{2}$ " backing strip approximately $1 / 4$ ", press and repeat to make a finished edge on (1) edge of the Backing Piece. Repeat with the second $14 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ " $201 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ Backing Piece.
5. Position and pin each back envelope flap, right sides together with the pillow front, overlapping the finished edges in the middle and aligning the raw edges with the pillow front (Fig. 4). Stitch around the pillow front and back to complete the pillow.
6. Turn the pillow right side out.

## Pillow \#2 Assembly

7. Sew (1) 2" x $10 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the 10 " Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2" x 13 " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square. Trim the block to measure 12" square to make (1) Unit 3 square (Fig. 5).
8. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " x 12 " Fabric C strip to each side of the Unit 3 square. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{4} 4^{\prime \prime} \times 131 / 2$ " Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 3 square to make (1) Unit 4 square (Fig. 6).
9. Sew (1) $13 / 4$ " x 11 " Fabric D strip to the left end of (1) $13 / 4$ " x 3 " Fabric E strip to make the top row. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip to each end of (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 5 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to make the middle row. Sew (1) $13 / 4$ " x $3^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric E strip to the left end of (1) $13 / 4$ " x 11 " Fabric D strip to make the bottom row. Sew the (3) rows together to make (1) Unit 5 strip (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (4) Unit 5 strips total.

10. Sew (1) 4" Fabric C square to each end of (1) Unit 5 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 5 strip to each side of the Unit 4 square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together to make the Pillow \#2 top.
11. Turn under the $201 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ edge of (1) $14 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $20 \frac{1}{2}$ " backing strip approximately $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$, press and repeat to make a finished edge on (1) edge of the Backing Piece. Repeat with the second $141 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 201 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Backing Piece.
12. Position and pin each back envelope flap, right sides together with the pillow front, overlapping the finished edges in the middle and aligning the raw edges with the pillow front (Fig. 9). Stitch around the pillow front and back to complete the pillow.
13. Turn the pillow right side out.

## Pillow \#3 Assembly

14. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 24 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 24 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip lengthwise to make (1) Unit 6 strip (Fig. 10). Repeat to make a second Unit 6 strip.
15. Sew together (1) $6 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 24 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip, (1) Unit 6 strip, (1) $6 \frac{1}{2 \prime} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 24 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A strip, (1) Unit 6 strip and (1) $6 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 241 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D strip, lengthwise and in that order from left to right, to make the Pillow \#3 top (Fig. 11).
16. Turn under the $24 \frac{1}{2}$ " edge of (1) $16 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 24 \frac{1}{2}$ " backing strip approximately $1 / 4$ ", press and repeat to make a finished edge on (1) edge of the Backing piece. Repeat with the second $161 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 241 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Backing piece.
17. Position and pin each back envelope flap, right sides together with the pillow front, overlapping the finished edges in the middle and aligning the raw edges with the pillow front (Fig. 12). Stitch around the pillow front and back to complete the pillow.
18. Turn the pillow right side out.

## Pillow \#4 Assembly

19. Follow Figure 13 and sew together (2) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric D squares, (2) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric C squares and (6) $37 / 8$ " Fabric B triangles to make (1) Unit 7 strip. Repeat to make (4) Unit 7 strips total.
20. Sew (1) $97 / 8$ " Fabric A triangle to each side of (1) unit 7 strip to make (1) Unit 8 square (Fig. 14). The square should measure $121 / 2$ ". Repeat to make (4) Unit 8 squares total.
21. Sew the (4) Unit 8 squares together into a $2 \times 2$ matrix to make the Pillow \#4 top (Fig. 15).

22. Turn under the $241 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ edge of (1) $16 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $24 \frac{1}{2}$ " backing strip approximately $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$, press and repeat to make a finished edge on (1) edge of the Backing Piece. Repeat with the second $161 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 241 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Backing Piece.
23. Position and pin each back envelope flap, right sides together with the pillow front, overlapping the finished edges in the middle and aligning the raw edges with the pillow front (Fig. 12). Stitch around the pillow front and back to complete the pillow.
24. Turn the pillow right side out.
