# Fabrics in the Love is in the Air Collection 



## Materials

1 panel Paris Panel - Light Blue (A)
$1 \frac{1}{4}$ yards Starlet - Berry (B)
1688P-17 6383-Berry*
$13 / 8$ yards Eiffel Tower with Flowers and Butterflies - White (C) 1679-01
$2 / 3$ yard Starlet - Petal (D)
$1 / 2$ yard Hearts - White (E)
$3 / 8$ yard Butterflies - Light Blue (F)
$5 / 8$ yard Eiffel Tower - White on White (G)
$3 / 8$ yard Floral Collage - Pink (H)
$21 / 8$ yards Hot Air Balloons - White (I)
$51 / 8$ yards Scenic - Green (Backing)
*Includes binding
Batting: 72" x 92"
(Recommended: Air Lite ${ }^{\circledR}$ Colour Me 100\% Cotton)

## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

## From the Paris Panel - Light Blue (A):

- Fussy cut (1) $221 / 2 " \times 421 / 2 "$ rectangle, centered on the panel.

From the Starlet - Berry (B), cut:

- (2) $2 " \times 421 / 2 "$ WOF strips, piece as needed.
- (2) 2 " x $251 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
-(4) $1 \frac{1}{2} " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 721 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 541 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
-(8) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for the binding.
From the Eiffel Tower with Flowers and Butterflies White (C), cut:
-(2) $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 441 / 2 "$ Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) $61 / 2 " \times 361 / 2 "$ WOF strips, piece as needed.


## From the Starlet - Petal (D), cut:

- (3) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 561 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) $11 / 2 " \times 381 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
-(4) $11 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 621 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) $1 \frac{1}{2} " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 441 / 2 "$ strips.


## From the Hearts - White (E), cut:

- (3) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $21 / 2 " \times 581 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) $21 / 2 " \times 421 / 2 "$ WOF strips, piece as needed.

From the Butterflies - Light Blue (F), cut:

- (2) $41 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (15) $41 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Eiffel Tower - White on White (G), cut:
-(4) $41 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (29) $41 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Floral Collage - Pink (H), cut:
-(2) $41 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (14) $41 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Hot Air Balloons - White (I), cut:

- (2) $51 / 2 " \times 741 / 2 "$ LOF strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) $51 / 2 " \times 641 / 2 "$ WOF strips, piece as needed.

From the Scenic - Green (Backing), cut:
-(2) $92 "$ x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the $72 " \times 92 "$ back.

## Block Assembly

Note: The arrows figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 421 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the 22 $1 / 2 " \times 421 / 2 "$ Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2" x $251 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure $241 / 2 "$ x $441 / 2$ ".

2. Follow Figure 2 and sew together (8) $41 / 2 "$ Fabric G squares, (4) $41 / 2 "$ Fabric F squares and (4) $41 / 2 "$ Fabric H squares to make the Left Side Border.
3. Follow Figure 3 and sew together (8) $41 / 2$ " Fabric G squares, (4) $41 / 2 "$ Fabric F squares and (4) $41 / 2 "$ Fabric H squares to make the Right Side Border.

4. Follow Figure 4 and sew together (6) $41 / 2 "$ Fabric G squares, (4) $41 / 2 "$ Fabric F squares and (3) $41 / 2 "$ Fabric H squares to make the Top Border.

5. Follow Figure 5 and sew together (7) $41 / 2 "$ Fabric G squares, (3) $41 / 2 "$ Fabric F squares and (3) $41 / 2 "$ Fabric H squares to make the Bottom Border.

Quilt Top Assembly
(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)
6. Sew (1) $6^{1 / 2 "} \times 44^{1 / 2}$ " Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $61 / 2 " \times 361 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
7. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2} " \times 56^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 38^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
8. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 581 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 421 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
9. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2} " \times 62^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 441 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
10. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and to the right sides of the Center Block.
11. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
12. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 721 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $541 / 2$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
13. Sew (1) $5^{1 / 2 "} \times 74^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $51 / 2 " \times 641 / 2 "$ Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
14. Layer and quilt as desired.
15. Sew the (8) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
16. Bind as desired.
