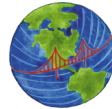
IDEAS FOR EMBROIDERING YOUR BOOKS

An adorable way to embellish your knitted books is to make them look like antiquarian books by embroidering the front cover and spine with gold or copper embroidery floss. I used my own hand-dyed silk embroidery floss, but any embroidery floss will work.

Before blocking your knitted cover “pouch,” use a full thread (e.g., do not separate the strands), and freehand embroider the knitted fabric in whatever way looks pleasing to you.

In these pages, I have drawn a few ideas for you to use as guides or jumping off points for your own creativity.

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
