## Sentinel DG4 Flatbed - LMS

A brand new introduction to the Oxford vintage truck line-up will delight 1:76 scale, 00 gauge railway enthusiasts, particularly those of you with affection for the London, Midland & Scottish fleet.

The Sentinel Waggon Works had started life as Alley & MacLellan of Glasgow back in 1875, concentrating on steam vehicles. The Scottish company acquired a similar Shropshire based operation in 1903, subsequently moving its steam wagon manufacturing to Shrewsbury around 1915 where it concentrated on the manufacture of steam powered lorries, steam wagons, railway locomotives and later, diesel powered lorries, buses and locomotives. The DG4 (Double geared) vehicle was introduced around 1931. During this time Sentinel along with Foden - dominated the steam vehicle market but by 1934 Government legislation

was demanding a move to lighter lorries which saw the demise of both companies. Sentinel became part of Rolls-Royce ultimately.

The familiar LMS maroon, black and gold colour scheme comes into its own on this model of the DG4 which, as a flatbed, would have been ideal for moving loads around railway yards particularly. It is registered AWW 9126 and comes with glazed cab windows. The gold chimney surrounded by silver rails protrudes from the interior of the cab which itself is moulded in black. The gold LMS lettering is printed across the front of the cab and also on the cab doors. The LMS initials appear again spaced along the flatbed edge, while the flatbed floor is painted a light brown colour. It would be great to add your own loads to this vehicle and there are many Oxford options to choose from.

## Land Rover Discovery 1 - Foxfire Red

Here at Oxford we fill another gap in the Land Rover line-up with the newly tooled Land Rover Discovery Series I. Appearing in 1:43 scale the model is based on the vehicle which Land Rover produced between 1989 and 1998. Registered F981 ENV from 1998, ours is representative of the last year of manufacture.

In real life, the Discovery 1 followed some of the finer features of the Range Rover with the same chassis, suspension and 4 wheel drive system. It was designed, however, at a more affordable price point and was aimed at the daily driving family market whilst still maintaining the off road facility.

Our 1:43 scale model incorporates all the fine visual features of the original. The interior replicates the

authentic Sonar Blue, enhanced with a Sonar Grey dashboard, steering wheel and door panels. Additional interior features include black floor mats, grey interior door handles, gearstick and hand brake.

The exterior bodywork is a metallic red colour scheme with black and silver trim. Side body and rear window flashes are finished in grey, silver and a fine blue stripe. Detailed roof bars, rear mud flaps, wheel centres and bolts are all black. The spare wheel appears fixed off centre on the rear full width door to the right of the number plate.

The Discovery 1 retained the chunky utility vehicle function for which Land Rover was historically renowned, while incorporating many refinements aimed at comfort and economy in an ever competitive automotive world.

## Riley Elf MkIII - Damask Red/Whitehall Beige

Another great authentic colour scheme introduces the latest release of the 1960s Riley Elf in a deep red with a beige/grey roof. It is registered KFC 382F from 1967, a year before the Riley marque was absorbed into British Leyland Motors in 1968. A year later again, British Leyland announced the end of Riley production altogether. The Riley Elf had been introduced in 1961 when this small car sported front wheel drive and a 4-cylinder in-line, 850 cc engine. Its top speed was 70 mph. Upgraded in 1963 to the 988cc Mk.II, it could reach 75 mph and our tooling choice - the Mk.III Elf - had even more refinements with inside door hinges and improved suspension. Our Riley Elf Mk III replicates the two door, four seater car launched in 1966. Its rich red exterior colour scheme

is echoed with a red interior and seating against a mid brown dashboard. The exterior trim is mostly chrome including the Elf III 'signature' across the boot. A finishing touch sees the diamond shaped Riley badge in bright blue set into the chrome radiator grille.

## Renault 4 - Marron Glacé

The Renault 4 had a great following, which contributed to its manufacture of over 8 million vehicles from 1961 right up to the 1990s. Classed as an economical family car, it was very versatile and came into its own in town or country as it was comfortable, had good suspension, a reasonably sized engine, as well as the option of a 3-speed manual or 4-speed manual gearbox. It had a top speed of 65 mph. A cheaper version omitted the quarter lights behind the rear seats but this option eventually became the norm and the extra windows were fitted as standard. Our Oxford model is the 1:76 scale replica of the 5-door estate Renault 4, complete with quarter lights. It is registered TPX 454K from 1971 and appears in chestnut

brown with a brown beige interior and dashboard. Exterior trim, bumpers and wheels is finished in chrome, and even the Renault marque is printed in chrome on the left hand side of the rear hatchback door. There's detail for you!

## Scooter - Gold

The colour scheme for Oxford's fourth 1960s Scooter release certainly echoes the regal mood of the moment with its gleaming gold bodywork and red, white and blue Union Flag emblazoned on the sides. Even the wheels are gold. The curved number plate round the front mudguard reveals our scooter is registered HJB 925. Further detail includes a black seat with backrest, a spare tyre fixed behind, as well as silver trim to handlebars and headlight surrounds. It would certainly cut a dash even today.

## New Defender 90 - Godwana Stone

Land Rover's new Defenders were launched at the Frankfurt Motor Show in 2019. Made in the company's plant in Slovakia, the vehicle was designed by Jaguar Land Rover's UK designer, Gerry McGovern. Engineered to comply with global car regulations, the car shares no component or technology with previous Defender models. It features permanent all-wheel drive, locking differentials and a ZF 8-speed automatic transmission. The new models also have an aluminium unibody. The New Defender 90 is a three-door, short wheelbase model. With a 196 bhp 2.0 litre 4-cylinder turbo diesel

engine, it returns a maximum speed of 109 mph, acceleration of 0-60 in 9.6 seconds and fuel consumption of 32.2 mpg. A petrol hybrid engine is also an option. The New Defender 90 makes its third Oxford entrance in Godwana Stone, one of the authentic colour schemes of the real life-series. It is registered 143 UYP and against the dark gold bodywork and black roof, the exterior trim is almost all black apart from the rear number plate housing, the wheels and the lower front grille section. The interior is also black. With a price tag of around £40,000 you can expect certain luxuries to come as standard - LED headlights, heated seats and heated steering wheel for starters. Very nice.

## Austin Cambridge A60 Farina - Fern Green/Snowberry White

The Austin Cambridge was another 1960s family saloon to emerge from the famous Morris Cowley Works in Oxford. It ceased production in 1969 with sales having reached over a quarter of a million. Features included a 1.6L engine and 3-speed automatic or 4-speed manual gearbox.

Our latest release of the Austin Cambridge is registered 5464 ML and is decorated in the authentic colour scheme of Fern Green with a white flash between chrome stripes along the waist. A silver finish has been applied to the bumpers, wheels and radiator grille as well as door handles, window surrounds and the twin mirrors

positioned on the bonnet. The radiator also displays the black and silver Austin badge and the boot carries the Austin Cambridge signature printed in silver.

The Cambridge was succeeded by the Maxi and the Marina, both of which star in our Oxford 1:76 series.

## Austin 1300 GT - Limeflower

In October 1969, BMC unveiled the Issigonis designed front engine, front-wheel drive Austin/Morris 1300 GT at the London Motor Show, when key features included a 1275 cc twin carburettor engine, a black full width grille, black vinyl roof and a thick black metal strip along the side, all designed to convey a sporty image. In 1971 the Mark III version appeared, lasting in production until 1974.

For its latest outing, our four-door Austin 1300 GT is registered JMA 849L from 1972. The authentic paint scheme is typical of the marque, appearing here in a muted green shade with its black 'vinyl' roof. The interior

seating is moulded in a lighter yellowy green shade. Its GT logo features in red and silver on the radiator grille and its 1300 GT status is also printed on the offside of the boot. The broad black and silver stripe associated with the GT appears along both sides.

## VW Karmann Ghia - Black/Lotus White

Oxford's first release on the 1950s Karmann Ghia hit your diecast shelf in a brilliant red with white roof.

Now it makes an equally dramatic entrance in black with a creamy white roof registered 170 NHU.

The Karmann Ghia was manufactured from 1955 until 1974, with over 445,000 being produced between the Ghia Works and the VW Osnabrück plant. It had been a highly successful collaboration between Wilhelm Karmann and the Italian Carrozzeria Ghia Company and it was snapped up by VW.

All the distinctive detail is here on our 1:76 scale model.

The wheel inserts match the roof colour and this lovely cream colour has been used for the seats and the steering wheel. The Karmann Ghia 'signature' feature in silver across the boot alongside the Volkswagen name.

## VW T25 Camper - Liana Green

As caravans and camper vans set off on the road in search of the best campsites, we take a nostalgic trip back to the 1980s with our own VW T25 Camper Van. The stylish Westfalia with its 'Joker' logo on the driver and front passenger doors, is registered KOR 365Y from 1982. Its bright green body also features a white elevated roof section with the Westfalia name printed in black on the front edge. A silver grey band runs along the length of the lower body while the remaining exterior trim is mainly black. Inside, the colour scheme is pale cream with olive yellow seats. The rear seating would have accommodated all the family via the very useful sliding door. Happy camping, folks - we love it!

## VW Beetle - WRAC Provost, British Army on the Rhine

WRAC - the Women's Royal Army Corps was the corps to which all female Army personnel once belonged, having been setup just after World War II on 1st February 1949. It was the successor to the former ATS (Auxiliary Territorial Service) which had done such sterling work during the conflict. The Corps served in post-war Germany and it is here that our little 1:76 scale replica of the VW Beetle is stationed. Our Army styled Beetle is dressed in the military deep bronze green to the body with silver lines to it. The deep green colour also extends to the roof, bumpers and wheel surrounds/wheel centres. The running boards are black and the vehicle interior is pale grey. Registered with an Army number plate 79 XH 92, the model also

displays a colourful military crest with the Union Flag and Corps numbering on both the front and the back. For this release, note the addition of a WRAC Provost signboard fixed above the front number plate.

## Austin Healey Frogeye Sprite - Leaf Green

The much loved Sprite epitomised the 1950s/60s era of British sports cars, each with their individual characteristics. The Frogeye Sprite for instance came with no door handles and no exterior boot lid. You just stuffed everything behind the two seats! However, it had a top speed of 82mph, economic fuel consumption of 43 mpg and cost just £669.

Our Oxford model is based on the Mk I version of the real car which Dennis Healey and his team built at the Abingdon Works. For its latest outing, our Sprite is registered 471 FHU. The interior, including the dashboard, is finished in the same bright green as the

exterior bodywork.

Against the springtime leaf green, our Sprite sports a wealth of chrome trim to the exterior and don't miss the red and gold Austin Healey Sprite badge on the edge of the bonnet.

## Scania New Generation (S) Curtainside - Pollock Scotrans

This is the second release on Oxford's 1:76 scale S Series Scania, the first also hailing from Scotland. Now it is the turn of the popular and collectable Pollock Scotrans livery to take to the road in the Scania, which now features a curtainside trailer as opposed to a fridge.

The Pollock lorries are instantly recognisable on the motorways in the bright turquoise blue, red, white and gold colour scheme and graphics but this one has a high viz effect from the air as well printed with red alphanumeric M522 in the centre of the roof with the M facing the front of the vehicle. Registered simply EI PSL, our lorry is full of promotional and 'how to contact' graphics from one end to the other but don't miss one

small detailed caption printed right across the tartan riband along the top of the

radiator grille reading Scotland Trailblazer England.

Turning to the real thing, the Scania S series cab is the result of a complete makeover both technically and practically, now offering the ultimate in comfort for the long distance driver.

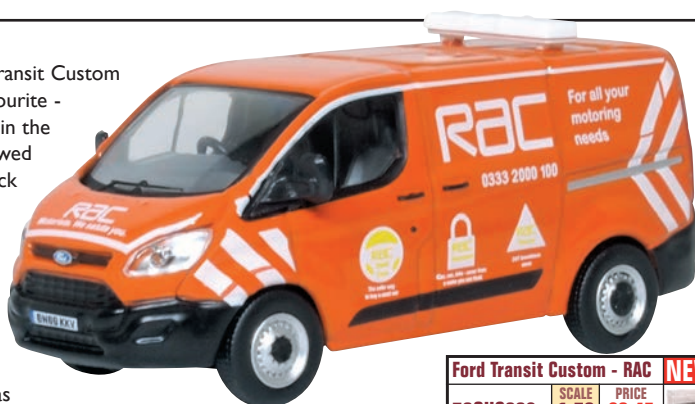
Scania have refined the exterior of the cab too and our Oxford model captures these new visual improvements including the lowered side windows and larger windscreen already mentioned above. In addition, the cab front, improved roof and enhanced side air deflectors are all aerodynamically designed to reduce fuel consumption.

This latest upmarket addition to the Scania fleet represents a further chapter in the Oxford Scania story.

Now it's back again in the bright modern RAC colour scheme of orange and white, registered BN66 KKV. The detailed printing processes give us masses of information along the sides and the back, promoting everything the RAC does from its used car advisory scheme, insurance facilities as well as breakdown recovery and care, online shopping, RAC approved garages and much more. The interior is grey and a roof lightbar has been added towards the rear of the roof. We love the slogan across the front of the sloping bonnet - RAC We Salute You - a reminder of when the RAC roadside patrols did just that when they saw a member's badge on the front of their motor.

## Aveling Barford Dumper Truck - Royal Engineers

Tooled up to accommodate the AEC 690, Aveling Barford and Scammell LD55 chassis, we've chosen the Aveling Barford option for our Royal Engineers vehicle, the third release on this versatile Dumper Truck.

Decorated in the familiar bronze green military scheme, the all-over garb is lightened only by a pebble grey panel behind the seats. The truck is registered 01 FX 50 and features the Royal Engineers Cipher on the doors with the Crown, Royal Insignia, as well as the Royal Engineers crest colourfully inscribed in gold, green, blue and red.

The heavy duty specification for the vehicle is mind-blowing. The engine was a 4-stroke, 6-cylinder, vertical, direct injection diesel. Output was 192 bhp at 2000 rpm with a maximum torque of 557 Lh-ft (77kg-m) at 1100 rpm. The front suspension had 3 1/2" wide inverted semi-elliptical leaf springs with rubber pump stops and telescopic double acting hydraulic damper. The rear bogie had 3 1/2" wide inverted semi-elliptical leaf springs pivoted at their centres on a transverse tube, mounted in cast steel brackets bolted on to the chassis frame. Definitely built to last and to do whatever is demanded of it!

It's back to a fast and furious colour scheme for this latest Thunderbird with its dramatic black livery and bright red roof. It hails from Texas as HB 3671 in 1956 and sports this usual high level of chrome and whitewall

tyres. The T Bird logo sits on the edge of the bonnet above an impressive radiator grille while the Thunderbird name is printed in silver on the wings behind the rear wheels. The circular porthole windows to the sides are also a nice feature, true to the original. The interior and the steering wheel are also bright red.

The number plate reads Colorful (sic) California 59 323, 1954 and our 1954

Buick Century Estate

is aptly described, having a bright two-tone colour scheme of pale green body with a white roof.

he seats are a darker leaf green, exterior trim is finished in chrome with a wiped black radiator grille and the customary white wall tyres.

The Century name represented six generations of cars aimed at varying markets. All of them, including the 1954 station wagon featured an FR layout which incorporated

a transverse front engine and rear wheel drive. The Buick Century Estate Wagon represented one of the second generation of vehicles produced between 1954 and 1958 and was classed as an upscale, full-sized car.

## 1957 Cadillac Eldorado Brougham - Sandalwood

Our Oxford replica in 1:87

scale is from the third era

of the Cadillac Eldorado,

panning the short period

between 1957 and 1958,

when it was produced

with a distinctive body

shell and rear wheel drive.

With four doors, there was a choice

of a convertible or closed top and our Oxford replica

is closed. Elegant detailing included low down swept bumpers, elaborate tail fins with a steel 'beauty panel' section that ran from the rear wheel arches into the rear bumpers. Even the top edges of the tail fins are finished in chrome while the front bumper came in three sections.

All these physical details are here on our replica,

## 1942 Chrysler T & C Woody Wagon - Catalina Tan

It's the middle of World War II for this chunky Chrysler Town & Country luxury station wagon which was made between 1941 and 1942 and again after the war. Our replica of the first generation vehicle from 1942 shows off its unique shape and unusual features. The four door saloon was styled with either a wood body or metal designed to look like wood. Unbelievably, the car could take up to nine people and rear loading was via centrally opening double doors.

You can see all these physical features on the Oxford replica which is decorated in a stone beige colour with light and dark tan wood effect to create a mahogany finish. The interior is a brown red colour with beige

steering wheel. The roof rack rails, bumper trim and wheels are chrome and our car sports whitewall tyres. It is registered in Florida 1942 as number 22 D 2736.

## 1959 Imperial Crown 2-door hardtop - Radiant Red/Black

After the warm pale Persian Pink and then the fresh green of the first two Oxford Imperial Crown releases, this one is

certainly a lot more dramatic.

Registered in New Jersey, the Garden State with number 616 GPO, the red and black colour scheme also features a black interior. The exterior chromework positively gleams against the dark red. The gold boot badge is another fine detail.

The motor services being offered are printed in pale cream and maroon along the sides and the Dodge name is printed across the back. Dan seems to have expertise with Brakes & Shocks, Oil and Lube and is Number 1 for Service. His Dodge vehicle features

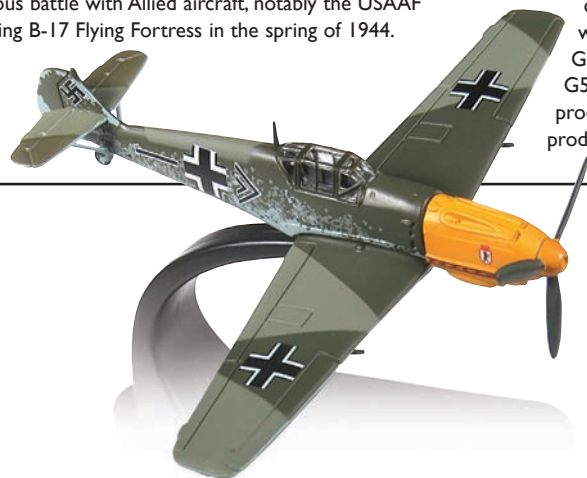
**Fiat G55 Centauro -  
Montefusco-Bonet Squadra 1944**

The Fiat G55 Centauro was a single engine, single seat Italian fighter plane which took part in the Italian Campaign between 1943 and 1945. It was designed by Italian Guiseppe Gabrielli and manufactured by Fiat Aviazione but coming so late into the conflict only about 275 were made before the end of the war. However, it was robust, fast and powerful and proved itself as an excellent interceptor plane at high altitudes where it was quite a match for Allied aircraft. It was flown primarily by the Regia Aeronautica and the Aeronautica Nazionale Repubblicana (ANR). The first unit in the ANR to be equipped with the G55 was the Montefusco Squadra in November 1943, operating until March 1944 in Piemonte. The Bonet connection was a commemorative act by the Squadra in memory of their Commander, Captain Giovanni who was shot down and killed during a furious battle with Allied aircraft, notably the USAAF Boeing B-17 Flying Fortress in the spring of 1944.

The 1:72 Oxford replica of the G55 is from this time, decorated in the dark green and earth brown camouflage colours with light grey underside. The Italian national flag features on both sides of the fuselage and tail fins. The fuselage also sees the Squadra insignia 'Centauro Serie I MM 91147' printed on both sides in blue and yellow. One unusual detail comprises the black and white squares containing the fasces (bundle) on both the upper and underside of the wings. This is an Italian symbolic 'bundle' which goes back to Roman times, representing wooden rods tied together with an axe in the middle. The ANR carried on this tradition, putting the feature on their G55 aircraft during WWII. The propeller spinner is also black and white; the blades are black with yellow tips. Exhausts pipes are rusty brown and the pitot tubes silver.

The Fiat G55 was such an effective little aircraft that it caught the attention of the German Luftwaffe who had captured examples for evaluation in Germany. They went on to manufacture some G55s but it was late in the day for them and production was small. However, later Italian production echoed the German influence.

## VW T1 Samba Bus - Sealing Wax Red/Beige Grey

Enthusiasts of 1:76 scale Oxford models have already been treated to this tooling variation of the VW T1 Camper. Now it's been downsized as a welcome addition to the N scale series too. The VW T1 Samba Bus also belonged to the first generation of the T1, emerging in 1951 and was the most luxurious version. Differentiating features included two pivot doors at the side and a fabric sunroof. It had a wealth of windows, too - up to 23 in some cases. VW's advertising used this feature to promote the T1 as a great vehicle for scenic tours! The Samba came with two-tone bodywork separated

by a decorative strip.

Our 1:148 scale model captures all the detail of the real thing and is also an exact replica of its larger Oxford counterpart. Colourwise it appears here in a muted red with a beige grey upper body and off white roof panel. Registered 192 YUD, the interior seating, floor and steering wheel are moulded in the same off-white as the roof panel while the dashboard echoes the red body colour. White bumpers, chrome and red wheels and silver body trim complete the effect. It makes you want to get aboard and have a change of scenery.
