

KITCHEN

Application	Product	How to Apply
All Purpose Cleaner	Citric Acid / Sodium Carbonate / Sodium Percarbonate	Make a thick paste using product or mix with water and add to spray bottle.
Bins	Sodium Bicarbonate	Sprinkle some product in the bin to absorb bad odours.
Chopping Board Disinfectant	20% Acetic Acid	Wipe with product after each use. Rinse normally.
Coffee Maker Cleaner	20% Acetic Acid	Place 2 cups white vinegar and 1 cup water. Leave to soak, then rinse.
Countertops	Citric Acid	Mix 5-10 teaspoons of citric and 200ml of water in a spray bottle and use in affected area.
Dirty Tea Towels	Sodium Carbonate	Mix 4-6 teaspoons of product and 100ml hot water, leave to soak for few hours. Rinse.
Dishwasher Cleaner	20% Acetic Acid	Add a cup of vinegar to rinse compartment and run for entire cycle.
Dishwasher Detergent	Citric Acid	Add a tablespoon of citric acid to each dishwasher cycle to soften the water.
Eliminate Bin Germs	20% Acetic Acid	Spray onto area and leave for 10 minutes. Rinse.
Floor Cleaner	20% Acetic Acid	Combine 2 parts vinegar with 1 part water to make a solution when mopping.
Fridge Odour	Sodium Bicarbonate	Add some sodium bicarbonate in a bowl and leave open in the fridge to absorb smells.
General Limescale Removal	Citric Acid	Make a paste with water and apply to surface, leave for 10 mins and rinse.

Greasy Pans	20% Acetic Acid / Sodium Bicarbonate	Mix 2 tablespoons of sodium bicarbonate with 1 tablespoon of vinegar to form a foaming mix. Apply to a damp cloth and clean.
Humidifier Limescale	Citric Acid	Add a teaspoon of citric and mix with water remove limescale.
Kettle Descaler	Citric Acid / 20% Acetic Acid	Add a few teaspoons of citric/ cup of acetic into the kettle, add water, boil and rinse.
Oven Cleaner	Caustic Soda	Mix 100g of caustic soda with 1L of water carefully, and pour into a spray bottle. Apply to built up grease and let sit for 10 minutes. Caustic soda will dissolve the fats. Wipe away the excess and let it dry.
Removing Coffee Maker Stains	Citric Acid	Add a few teaspoons of citric into the kettle, add water, boil and rinse.
Removing Grease and Stains	Sodium Bicarbonate	Mix 2 tablespoons of sodium bicarbonate with 1 tablespoon of acetic acid to form a foaming mix. Apply to a damp cloth and clean.
Removing Marble Stains	Sodium Bicarbonate	Make a thick paste out of baking soda and water. Smooth the paste over the stain and cover it with plastic wrap. Let it sit for 24 hours. Remove the plastic and wipe off the paste with a damp cloth.

BATHROOM

Application	Product	How to Apply
General Limescale Removal	Citric Acid	Add a teaspoon of citric and mix with water to make a paste, apply on affected area, leave for 20 minutes and rinse.
Hard Water Stains (Shower etc.)	Citric Acid / 20% Acetic Acid	Spray/ pour 20% acetic acid on to your taps and leave on for 1 hour, use a clean cloth to wipe away for a stain free tap.
Mirror Cleaner	20% Acetic Acid	Spray acetic acid to surface then wipe using newspaper.
Porcelain Sink Cleaner	Sodium Bicarbonate	Make a paste of sodium bicarbonate and water and scrub area.
Removing Soap Scum	Citric Acid	Mix citric with water and add to spray bottle, spray affected area.
Shining Silver	20% Acetic Acid / Sodium Bicarbonate	1/2 cup vinegar and 2 tablespoons baking soda for two to three hours. Rinse them under cold water.
Shower Head Descale	Citric Acid / 20% Acetic Acid	Tie a bag with acetic acid around it overnight to remove calcium deposits and hard water stains.
Shower Tub	20% Acetic Acid / Sodium Bicarbonate	Spray vinegar, leave for few minutes and scrub and rinse. Add Sodium bicarbonate and scrub for tough grime.
Sink Drain Cleaner	Sodium Bicarbonate / 20% Acetic Acid	Pour in ½ cup of sodium bicarbonate into drain then a cup of 20% acetic acid and let it sit for 15 minutes. Rinse with hot water.
Soap Scum	Citric Acid	Mix citric with water and add to spray bottle, apply.
Tile and grout	Citric acid	Make a strong solution of citric and water, spray and wipe.
Toilet	Citric Acid / Caustic Soda Pearls / 20% Acetic / Sodium Percarbonate	Pour in toilet and let it sit for few hours then scrub to whiten toilet bowl.
Window Cleaner	20% Acetic Acid	Use a microfibre cloth and wipe using a solution of equal parts vinegar and water.

OUTSIDE

Application	Product	How to Apply
BBQ Grill Cleaner	Caustic Soda Pearls	Mix 100g of caustic soda and 1 litres of cold water very carefully, apply to built up grease and let it sit for 10 minutes, wipe the excess and rinse.
Drain Cleaner	Caustic Soda Pearls	Add 3 cups (750ml) of caustic soda to 3 litres of water and stir gently with a wooden spoon. Pour immediately into drain, leave undisturbed for 30 minutes then rinse with 4 litres of boiling water.
Path/Driveway Cleaner	Sodium Carbonate	Sprinkle sodium carbonate directly on to the moss/slime areas and wet the area.
Pool PH Change	Sodium Carbonate	Add 28 grams of sodium carbonate per 4.5L of pool water to raise the pH level by 0.2.
Rust Removal	20% Acetic Acid	Place rusted item in a container with white vinegar—enough to thoroughly soak. Most effective on small rusts.
Sanitising Outside Area	Caustic Soda Pearls	Add 1-2 tablespoons caustic soda per 5 litres of water. Scrub area with solution then rinse with cold water.
Shining Silver	20% Acetic Acid/Sodium Bicarbonate	1/2 cup vinegar and 2 tablespoons baking soda for two to three hours. Rinse them under cold water.
Wheelie Bin Cleaner	Caustic Soda Pearls	Add 1-2 tablespoons caustic soda per 5 litres of water. Scrub area with solution then rinse with cold water.
Window Cleaner	20% Acetic Acid	Use a microfibre cloth and wipe using a solution of equal parts vinegar and water.

HOUSEHOLD

Application	Product	How to Apply
All Purpose Cleaner	Sodium Carbonate / Citric Acid	Mix a tablespoon of product with 2 cups of water and use as a spot cleaner.
Carpet Pre-spotter	Sodium Percarbonate	Add 30g of sodium percarbonate per litre of water. Apply to stain, ensuring that it is well soaked and leave for up to 10 minutes. Lift residue with paper towelling and repeat cleaning if necessary. After carpet has been cleaned, rinse with clean water absorb with towelling. Repeat rinsing.
Clean Dirty Shoes	Sodium Bicarbonate	Mix water and baking soda to make a paste, grab an old toothbrush and scrub the surface of the trainers.
Cleaning Machine	Sodium Percarbonate	Make up a solution of 25g of sodium percarbonate in 1L of water. Switch on machine and pour in the solution and allow it to circulate. Drain off solution and rinse thoroughly by circulating clean water through the machine.
Dried Dough Mixture on Clothes	Sodium Bicarbonate	Mix a few tablespoons of Sodium bicarbonate with cold water, soak for 20 mins, gently rub and the hardened pieces should fall off. Add sodbic to clothes to make a paste and scrub (it will act as an abrasive), soak another 20 mins, gently rub to remove any leftover pieces.
Fabric/Carpet Odour Removal	Sodium Bicarbonate	Add a few drops of essential oil on sodium bicarbonate and sprinkle on carpet, leave on for 1 hour and Hoover after.
Laundry Boost	Sodium Carbonate	You can pre-soak dirty clothes in a bucket with 1 cup soda ash and 1L of warm water, this will remove the dirt and stains then you can rinse as normal.
Mirror Cleaner	20% Acetic Acid	Spray acetic acid to surface then wipe using newspaper.

Removing Marble Stains	Sodium Bicarbonate	<p>Make a thick paste out of baking soda and water. Smooth the paste over the stain and cover it with plastic wrap. Let it sit for 24 hours.</p> <p>Remove the plastic and wipe off the paste with a damp cloth.</p>
Rust Removal	20% Acetic Acid	<p>Place rusted item in a container with white vinegar—enough to thoroughly soak.</p> <p>Most effective on small rusts.</p>
Stain Remover	Sodium Percarbonate	<p>Soak items in a solution containing 60g of sodium percarbonate per litre of water, and leave for 15-20 minutes.</p> <p>Remove and rinse thoroughly.</p>
Wash Reusable Grocery Bags	Sodium Carbonate	<p>Soak bags in a mixture of sodium carbonate and water. Rinse.</p>
Wash Veggies	Sodium Bicarbonate	<p>Soak the fruits and veggies in a sodium bicarbonate wash for around 15 minutes.</p>
Wipe Off Wax/Polish Build Up	20% Acetic Acid	<p>When furniture polish or wax builds up on wood furniture or leather tabletops, get rid of it with diluted white vinegar.</p>
