Artist Splat Cake

Project Series No 23

Equipment:

FMM Splat Cutter Set
FMM Alphabet Upper Case
Letters & Numbers Tappit
FMM Multi Ribbon Set
FMM Dab-a-Dust
FMM Knife & Scriber Tool
Non Stick board & Rolling Pin

Modelling paste colours, Yellow, Blue, Red, Green White & Light Brown Small circle cutters from FMM Geometric Cutter Set 7" 1 Tier Round Cake covered white fondant Paintbrush Water (or edible glue if preferred) Pen, paper & scissors

HINTS AND TIPS:

- To make modelling paste add some tylo powder to your fondant. Modelling paste should always be rolled to 2mm thickness.
- We use Rainbow Dust Pro Gels to colour the fondant.
- Once you have cut out your shapes / text from modelling paste place them to one side to firm up. You will find the shapes / text easier to handle.
- 1. Draw a kidney bean shape on a piece of paper approximately 4" tall x 5" wide. Cut out with scissors. This is your artists paint palette template.
- 2. Roll out light brown modelling paste and place your paper template on top. Use the cutting wheel from the Multi-Ribbon set to cut out your shape.
- **3.** Cut out a small circle on your artists paint palette as shown in picture then allow this to dry completely. This will take 24 48 hours.
- 4. Roll out a sausage of light brown modelling paste to make the handle of your paintbrush. Make it thinner at the bottom and thicker at the top. Use your FMM Knife and Scriber Tool to make a neat cut at the top. Then use your white modelling paste to make the head of your paintbrush. Paint some colour to look like paint on the paintbrush head. Attach the brush head to your paintbrush with water. Cut out a thin strip of modelling paste and attach it around the join of your paintbrush head and handle.

- 5. Roll out yellow, green, red and blue modelling paste. Use both FMM Splat Cutters to cut out your splats. Attach them to your cake randomly with water, as shown in picture.
- 6. Roll out yellow, green, red and blue modelling paste. Use the Alphabet Upper Case Letters and Numbers tappit to cut out a few of each of the letters ABC and 123. Attach them to your cake randomly with water.
- 7. Use the Small Circle Cutter from FMM Geometric Cutter Set to cut out a yellow, green, red and blue circle from modelling paste and attach them to your artists paint palette as shown in picture.
- 8. Once the paint palette is fully dry it can be secured to the top of your cake. Make a cube from the white modelling paste. Attach this to your cake with water. Wet the front of your cube of white modelling paste and attach the artists paint palette to it. You will need to support it until it stays in place on it's own. Attach the paintbrush to your cake with water.
