#### **LABEL INSTRUCTIONS**

### **Product Description & Directions for Use:**

A powerful, non-ammoniated floor polish stripper formulated for the removal of metallised acrylic emulsion floor polish and light buffable wax floor polish.

## For professional and industrial use only.

Sweep and dust mop floor to remove loose soil.

Dilute 125ml of Prostrip per litre of warm water (1 to 8).

Apply solution with mop, then machine scrub floor with black stripping pad.

Remove slurry with mop or wet pick-up vacuum.

Rinse floor thoroughly with water or C255 Prorinse solution and allow to dry. Apply Proshine emulsion floor polish according to label directions.

- Floor polish stripper and heavy duty cleaner.
- Can be applied with mop or rotary scrubbing machine.
- Dark blue liquid with mild odour.

pH Concentrate: 13.0 pH Diluted: 12.0
