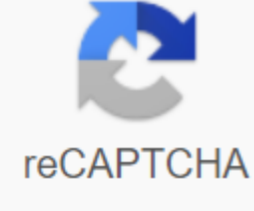




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Gun stock refinishing service

A full blown custom rifle package will include action work, bocho case, and stock work. You can provide your own action rifle or I can provide one for you. The action work consists of an action melody that involves splashing hatches until there is 95% contact between bolt hatches and locking in recesses in action. It also includes facing the front ring receiver, and truing the bolt face (when necessary), so that the run out of bolt face is held by less than 0.001 inches. Barreling starts with a custom barrel of your choice, which is then chambered in the caliber you want, head, dissalized accordingly, cut to length and topped with your choice of eleven degrees or a sunk goal crown. Admissions for barrel work are all held up to less than 0.001 inches. The metal work is completed with bluing in a polished or matte finish (stainless action and barrels are not blue, but still finished in polish or matte), and finally the caliber is engraved (not stamped) on the trunk. Custom stock work starts with selecting stock blank that matches your budget and taste. He will then be sent in a semi-inletter and rough to the desired scheme. After half-time, I'll finish the entrance so that the tree looks as if it's growing out of metal. The rifle is then laid in a warehouse with free swimming mounted on the trunk. After the bedding the gunstock is formed to its final size and finished with your choice of high glitter, or classic oil finish. This is a brief summary of the custom rifle job. There are many custom features that you can add to the rifle including muzzle brake, custom triggers, area mounts or open scopes, tip and wood cover, cover insertion, etc. you customer will have a hand in choosing features for custom rifles every step of the way. I'll be happy to give and help in the decision-making process. Together we can build the rifle of your dreams. I also work with synthetic stocks. McMillan shares is my first choice. BluingBoth hot salt bluing and rust bluing are offered at Brown Dog Gunsmithing. Hot salts are used for most blue guns, while rust bluing is reserved for double weapons. I offer three trim options for hot bluing salts, and one for rust bluing. With any bluing option the key to great bluing work in metal training before the gun ever hits bluing tanks. All pitting, scratching, orange peel, and rust surface will be removed wherever possible and possible (i.e. rust, but no pitting will be removed below the show lines of stock that keeps costs lower. Hot Salt Plant Polish: Plant Polish is similar to what you usually see in a factory gun that has no matte finish. The metal is polished through several stages, finishing with 400 sand trim and then turning blue. This is a very good classic kind of finish. Matte Finish: The matte finish is prepared as polish. The metal is polished to 320 sand finish to remove all stains, then all the pieces pass through the beaded blaster to give them a matte finish, before bluing. The matte finish is very good finish. It looks just as good as a polish plant, but cuts the shine on the finished product. Many hunters like this finish. A brief note about this finish. Some gunsmiths will cut corners by simply blasting parts and bluing them for a matte finish. This is not satisfactory, since it will not hide any of the pitting, scratching, or stains that the metal was before bluing. You'll have fresh bluing over poor metal training and you'll see it all. Be tricky with cheap prices, make sure you know what you're getting as you're likely to be disappointed in a poorly prepared bluing job. Exhibition Finish: The entire metal is polished to the mirror like a finish before bluing. It produces a very shiny final product and gives bluing a deeper look. There is a significant increase in time in preparatory work, thereby increasing the price. This trim is usually reserved for the show piece of gun. A pair of gun bluing work with a margin of refinish for the full recovery of the gun. Rust Bluing Factory Polish: Plant polish is similar to what you usually see in a factory gun. The metal is polished through the stages, finishing 400 sand trim and then turning blue. This is a very good classic kind of finish. This is the only suggestion under rust bluing bluing This finish takes rust bluing the best. Muzzle BrakesThe muzzle brakes that I install on Brown Dog Gunsmithing threaded at the end of the rifle barrel. All work is focused on the well in order to ensure proper alignment and to eliminate the possibility of a bullet hitting the brake when leaving the well. All tolerances are held with .001 inches. After the muzzle brake is installed, the outer diameter is swung into the diameter of the barrel. This gives the job a very clean look at making the muzzle brakes look an integral part of the rifle barrel. The muzzle brakes are fitted with tight hands and can be removed for cleaning. The muzzle brake will significantly reduce the amount of felt recoil of the rifle production. Muzzle brake work can be combined with the new Pachmayr Decelerator recoil pad for further reduction felt recoil in the rifle. Installing a blue muzzle brake on the barrel of a stainless rifle or vice versa can give your rifle a unique custom look. Giving back to PadsInstalling a new rollback pad is a pretty inexpensive way to make your rifle or shotgun more enjoyable to shoot. In my opinion, most factory pads are nothing more than cosmetic, and some of them down right is hard. I use Pachmayr pads almost exclusively for several reasons. First, and for most they work. Secondly, they set well and look very good when on a gun. All pads grind to fit so that the finished product looks like it belongs on the gun. Pachmayr offers a wide range of styles, colors, sizes and thicknesses, for rifles and shotguns, all available in Brown Dog Gunsmithing. If I don't have what you want in stock I order it. If necessary, the length of the pull can be adjusted on most guns before a new recoil pad is installed. Reduce by reducing inventory, or lengthening by adding pads or a thicker pad. Pair a new rollback pad with a brake muzzle on the rifle to significantly reduce felt recoil. Shotgun Shell InlaysA shotgun shell insertion is a good way to improve the look of your shotgun. Save the enclosure from your first 25 straight on the trap or skeet range, or from the first baby turkey, duck, goose, or pheasant. Its a great way to remember a significant hunt or achievement at the training ground. I'm going to take the head of the case off and put it in the gun' lid. This can be done on most guns, but there may be exceptions based on the design or construction of the warehouse. Note that the edge of the shell protrudes slightly above the tree (the thickness of the rim of the shell). This allows you to finish the job well. Antler InlaysAn horn insert will give your gun a really custom look. Hoof prints or initials are popular, and can make your gun uniquely yours. Stock RefinishingStock Recycling Is way to give new life of Betsy. Recycling consists of removing old finishes, pulling oil out of stock, repairing repairs and dings, resurfacing, and applying a new finish. Two varieties (hunter and exhibition) stock finishes are offered at Brown Dog Gunsmithing, and each variety can be finished in your choice of high glitter or classic oil finish. Hunter trim high quality utility-grade finishes. The hunter finish looks very good, is tough, and is weather-like. I use the same techniques and the same products for my hunter and exhibition finish. The difference is that the grain will not be completely filled with hunting finishes. After grinding a few layers of finishes are applied until the tree is well sealed and I have reached the look I want. The job is then completed. The finished product is similar to the average factory finish. The finish of the exhibition is as good as it gets. It looks like if not better than most factory finishes on high dollar guns. What makes the exhibit finish so good is the fact that all the wood grains are completely filled. Stocks will feel as smooth as glass when completed. The exhibition finish can have over 20 layers of finishes on models with high shine. The finish is manually applied and wet resurfacing is done between layers. The combination of coat and wet grinding is what fills the grain and gives the stock its smooth feel. Once the last layer of finish has dried the exhibition finish is additionally polished by hand rubbing with a rottenstone or other similar stock polishing compound. This eliminates the last of the drawbacks in finishing giving a stock of glass feel and depth that is unparalleled. It's a really fantastic view! Classic oil trim brings out the nostalgia of any modern or antique firearm. It not only protects your stock, but gives it the look of classic tools of history. It's both beautiful and functional, as well as my favorite. Both hunter and exhibition finishes can be done in your choice of high glitter or classic oil. In addition to the standard paint work, I suggest a textured finish that is applied in front of the top coat of paint. I use Dura coat products for all synthetic recycling stocks. Dovetail cutting and installation is another service offered. I'll also see in your firearm if you want and provide targets so you can see where the gun is firing. The overall WorkGeneral rifle work offered in Brown Dog Gunsmithing includes services such as headspace check, removal of stuck cases and live rounds from the camera, cutting and coronation barrels, and camera polishing. Trigger WorkTrigger's proposed work includes adjusting existing adjustable triggers, performing trigger jobs on unregulated triggers, and installing and setting up new triggers. All trigger work is done by performing all checks of functions and safety on the gun. The triggers will not be installed lower than possible. Misc Stock WorkI offers intake and bedding of both factory wood and synthetic stocks. I also have an entrance and bed stock blanks to meet your custom gunstock needs. My intake is very meticulous resulting in 1 to 1 metal wood fit. I recommend a free-floating barrel for the best possible accuracy, but there will be a full length bed on request. You can also buy bedding. Installation of standard and intake slings is available. FFL TransfersUse my federal firearms license is available for all your firearms transfer needs. If you purchased online or by mail, or need to receive a shipment from a friend or relative I will be happy to help. I can send my AFL by US email or email. Each AFL comes out with a letter accompanying it to notify the sender who is handing over and what the firearm is being transmitted. After receiving the firearm I will contact you and you can come to my store to fill out 4,473 documents. The cost of this service is \$20.00 for a firearm. Firearms Delivery ServiceNot is the only federal firearm license available to obtain firearms, I also send them. If you don't want the hassle of delivering a gun or can't do it legally I'll be happy to help. I'll box up the gun and send it to get the AFL to save you all the hassle and travel to the shipping depot. Please note: I must have a copy of the AFL used by the host in order to send the gun.
