

Emergency Procedures

FIRST AID

General First Aid for **HARMFUL, IRRITANTS, CORROSIVES** or products containing signal words **CAUTION, POISON, HAZARDOUS** or if **UNSURE**

SKIN CONTACT: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected area thoroughly under cold running water

EYES: Hold Eyes open and flood with cold water for 15 minutes

SWALLOWED: Do not induce vomiting; give a glass of water

INHALED: Remove to fresh air. If person not breathing ensure airways are clear and commence C.P.R

Refer to MSDS for detailed first aid information and any further actions required

SPILLS AND LEAKS

Report all spills and clean up immediately

1. Identify source of leakage and read appropriate handling.
2. Wear appropriate protective clothing.
3. If possible remove container/pack and store in a way to prevent further leakage.

LIQUIDS Absorb with sand or non combustible material, place in suitable container. Wash small residues with large with large amounts of water.

POWDERS Sweep up product and place in suitable labelled container. Wash small residues with large amounts of water.

RULES FOR SAFE HANDLING OF CHEMICALS

READ: the label, identify the hazards and precautions. **DO NOT** use unlabelled containers

WEAR: the appropriate protective clothing

USE PRODUCT DIRECTIONS: **TOO LITTLE** - ineffective cleaning. **TOO MUCH** or **WRONG**

APPLICATION: unnecessary hazards.

DILUTING CHEMICALS: **ALWAYS** fill first with water **THEN** add chemical.

PLACE LIDS: on containers before moving to avoid splashes.

DO NOT MIX CHEMICALS
