



TERMS & CONDITIONS:

The Cork City FC 'Corky Camps' are open to boys and girls between the ages of 5 & 14. The participant must be at least 5 years of age or no older than 14 years of age on the last day of the camp that they are attending.

Insurance:

All Corky Camps will be covered by Public Liability Insurance only.

Fees & Discounts:

Once the fees have been received, confirmation will be issued by email. The confirmation email is receipt of your place on the camp and payment received.

Medical Assistance:

All medical information must be provided in advance of the Corky Camp commencing. By signing up to the programme you give your permission to allow your child to be given medical treatment either by way of first aid by a suitably qualified person or by a doctor. You also consent to your child being taken to a doctor or hospital in case of emergency. If there is any change to the medical information you provided on your application form you must inform us prior to the Corky Camp commencing.

Damages/Injuries/Loss of Possessions:

Corky Camps will operate to the highest standards but Cork City FC will not be held responsible for damages, injuries or loss of possessions. We strongly recommend that no valuables are brought to the camp.

Conduct:

Participants must follow the instructions of the coaching staff in charge. Misbehaviour or bullying may result in the participant being expelled from the Corky Camp and any fees will not be refunded. In the interest of safety, participants are not permitted to leave the Corky Camp during the session times without the written consent of a parent/guardian. If a child is expelled from the Corky Camp their parent/guardian will be contacted immediately to collect the child.

**Clothing:**

All participants must wear appropriate clothing at all times throughout the duration of the camp. Retention of Data Policy Cork City Football Club will retain your entered data in relation to this camp sign up and contact you in future about potential camps. Please email camps@corkcityfc.ie if you would no longer like to be contacted in regards to future camps.

Photographic or Video Permission:

Sign up for Corky Camp is under the agreement that you allow Cork City FC to take photos/videos of your child involved in the camp for use in future promotional material for camps and social media updates throughout the camp. These may be published on Cork City FC's website, social media pages or match-day magazine.

Weather: In cases where the weather has affected the condition of the playing surface or is deemed so bad that coaching activities have to be suspended, the camp coordinator will contact the parent or guardian to advise them of the suspension of coaching activities. It will then be the responsibility of the parent/guardian to make arrangements to collect their child immediately. The coaching staff will supervise all children until they have been collected.

Cancellations & Camp Transfers:

Cancellations must be notified to camps@corkcityfc.ie at least 7 days in advance of the camp. All cancellations carry a €10 cancellation fee, except where the cancellation is made after the Corky Camp has commenced in which case there is no refund. It may be possible to facilitate transfer of bookings to alternative dates/venues where places are available.

Refunds:

No refunds will be issued for any cancellations made within 7 days of the camp starting or after the camp has commenced. In the unlikely event that inclement weather or COVID-19 restrictions force the cancellation of the camp's activities a full refund will be issued. If inclement weather or COVID-19 restrictions cause only partial cancellation of the camp, no refund will be issued. Cork City FC reserve the right to make date/time/venue changes if necessary.
