

## **EZB Bag Mounts Installation Instructions**

Remove fender/strut bolts and inner fender bracket. Do this one side at a time. Then using blue Loctite on gold nut threads, slide the gold nuts from the inside of the rear fender. The bag mount with the thinner gap in the plastic insert goes at the front towards the seat, and the mount with the larger gap in the plastic insert goes in the rear hole towards the back of the rear fender. That way if you are running a sissy bar it will be set up correctly. Now using a 3/4" box/open end wrench, hold the gold nut inside rear fender and use a 3/4" socket or another open end wrench and tighten them down. **DO NOT overtighten them as this will smash the insert and not allow clearance for sissy bar mounting points.** Make sure they are snug as the Loctite will keep them from vibrating apart. Once this is done, repeat on other side and then use proper length bolts for saddle bags. Note: You may have to space out your bags or add washers. We have added a small amount of Antiseize to thread of saddle bag mounting holes and these are the only threads that need it.

2005 and earlier will require drilling out the holes with a 1/2" drill bit.
