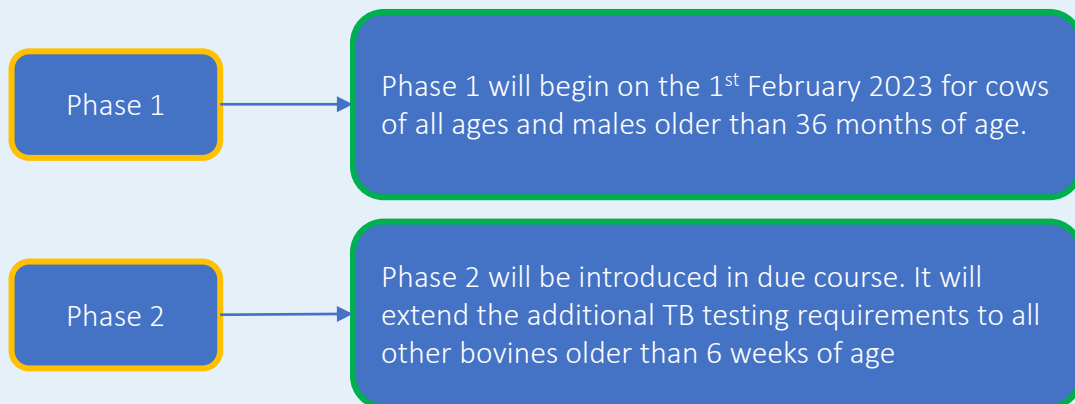


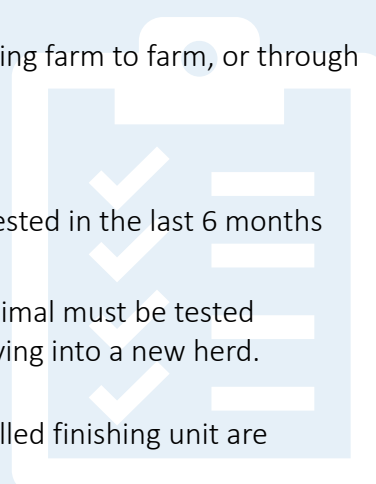
EU Animal Health Regulation 2016/429 TB testing Requirements

New TB testing requirements are being brought in as a result of the EU Animal Health Regulation 2016/429. This is being introduced on a phased basis.

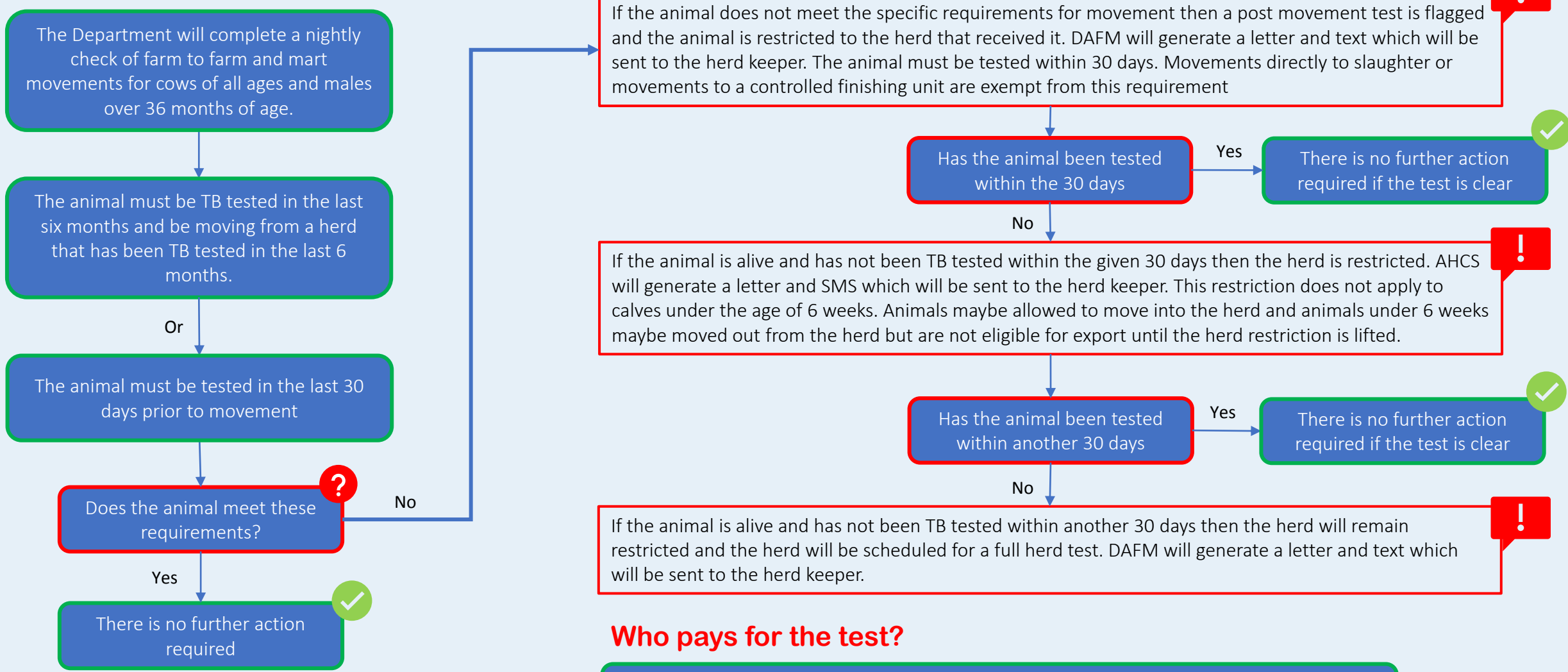


What are the new rules?

- Cows of all ages and males over the age of 36 months, moving farm to farm, or through a mart must be TB tested in the last 6 months
- and
- They must also be moving from a herd that has been TB tested in the last 6 months
- If they do not fulfil both of these requirements then the animal must be tested within 30 days prior to movement or within 30 days of moving into a new herd.
- Movements directly to slaughter or movements to a controlled finishing unit are exempt from the above requirements

Who pays for the test?

If a specific standalone TB test is required herd keepers will be required to pay for this test.
