Display

Press SET button to change display:

- * Alarm will sound at the set time each day until deactivated
- ** Press any button to silence alarm

Power Save Mode 1. Change display to TIME mode 2. Press DOWN button to activate

Power Save Mode ("oN Sd" will appear on the display)

3. Display will turn off after 10 seconds

3. Display will turn off after 10 seconds of inactivity4. Display will turn on again when clock is touched or loud poise created

 a. Display will turn on again when clock is touched or loud noise created
 b. To deactivate Power Save Mode change display to TIME mode and press DOWN button twice ("--Sd" will be displayed)

Clock Memory

When batteries are installed, the clock radio can be unplugged from the power outlet and moved to a new location without losing the set time.

Batteries Required:

3 x AAA Batteries 1 x CR2032 Back Up Battery (Supplied)

CAUTION: Don't mix old and new batteries. Do not mix standard (super heavy duty/alkaline), rechargeable and lithium batteries. Remove batteries when not in use for a prolonged period of time.
