

SAFETY CHECKLIST

Make sure to check these boxes every time you work with a torch.



FIRE EXTINGUISHER NEARBY

Make sure to have one sitting in a space where it will be easy to grab. Make sure you know how to use it and make sure you have it regularly serviced.



TIE YOUR HAIR BACK

Tie back those long gorgeous locks.



WEAR NATURAL FIBER CLOTHING

It's important to have on natural fiber clothing such as jeans and a cotton shirt or an apron made from natural fibers.



WELL VENTILATED ROOM

Make sure your room has an open window, exhaust hood, smoke/fume absorber or a way for the air to flow, and preferably flow out of the room. Placing a fan by the window to draw the air out is a great way to ventilate the room.



CLEAN WORK SURFACE

Nothing flammable on your work surface - no paper, tissues, steel wool etc. Make sure your surface is covered in a non combustible surface like a cookie sheet or a piece of sheet metal.



LOCK UP THE PETS AND KIDS 🤢

Make sure anyone who might distract you, is settled somewhere else.



PRACTICE TURNING YOUR TORCH ON AND OFF A FEW TIMES BEFORE BEGINNING

Practice turning your torch on and off so it's seamless, quick and easy.
