DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Always test fiber for color loss in an inconspicuous area prior to attempting stain removal. Do not apply to any color sensitive fibers, leather, satin, silk, suede, velvet, non-colorfast wool, or any fabric that can be damaged by water-based solutions.

CARPET

- 1. Apply product directly to stained area.
- 2. Using spotting tool or carpet brush, work into affected area.
- 3. Blot with clean, folded, white, terry cloth towel applying strong palm pressure or by standing on blotter with full body weight, shifting towel to clean areas as needed.

UPHOLSTERY

- 1. Apply product to a clean white terry cloth towel and rub/blot the stained area.
- 2. Moisten clean area of towel with product and repeat steps if necessary.

NOTE: When removing stains from clothing, first remove clothing and place absorbent blotter behind stained area before stain removal.

PRE-TREATMENT

- 1. Apply product directly to stain.
- 2. Fold fabric and rub stained area together.
- 3. Machine wash. If stain persists, repeat procedure before drying. Excessive heat from dryer may actually set stains into the fabric.
