Active Ingredients (in each packet)

Dextromethorphan HBr 5 mg
.....Cough suppressant
Guaifenesin 100 mg.....
.....Expectorant ▶

Drug Facts (continued)

Uses ■ helps loosen phlegm (mucus) and thin bronchial secretions to rid the bronchial passageways of bothersome mucus and make coughs more productive
■ temporarily relieves cough as may occur with a cold.

Warnings

Do not use if you are now taking a prescription monoamine oxidase inhibitor (MAOI) (certain drugs for depression, psychiatric, or emotional conditions, or Parkinson's disease), or for 2 weeks after stopping the MAOI drug. If you do not know if your prescription drug contains an MAOI, ask a doctor or pharmacist before taking this product.

Ask a doctor before use if you have

- persistent or chronic cough such as occurs with smoking, asthma, chronic bronchitis, or emphysema
- cough that occurs with too much phlegm (mucus)

When using this product do not use more than directed

Stop use and ask a doctor if cough lasts more than 7 days, comes back, or occurs with fever, rash, or headache that lasts. These could be signs of a serious condition.

If pregnant or breast-feeding, ask a healthcare professional before use.

Keep out of reach of children. In case of overdose, get medical help or contact a Poison Control Center right away.

Directions ■ empty entire contents of packet onto tongue and swallow
■ for best taste, do not chew granules
■ do not take more than 6 doses in any 24-hour period
■ dose as follows or as directed by a doctor

Age	Dose
adults and children 12 years of age and over	2 to 4 packets every 4 hours
children 6 years to under 12 years of age	1 to 2 packets every 4 hours
children 4 years to under 6 years of age	1 packet every 4 hours
children under 4 years of age	do not use ▶

Other information

- each packet contains:
magnesium 6 mg and sodium 3 mg
- **phenylketonurics:**
contains phenylalanine
2 mg per packet
- store at 20-25°C (68-77°F)

aspartame, butylated methacrylate copolymer, carbomer homopolymer type A, carboxymethylcellulose sodium, creme flavor, magnesium stearate, microcrystalline cellulose, orange flavor, povidone, sodium bicarbonate, sorbitol, stearic acid, talc, triethyl citrate
