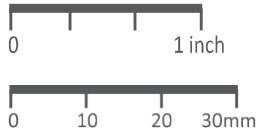


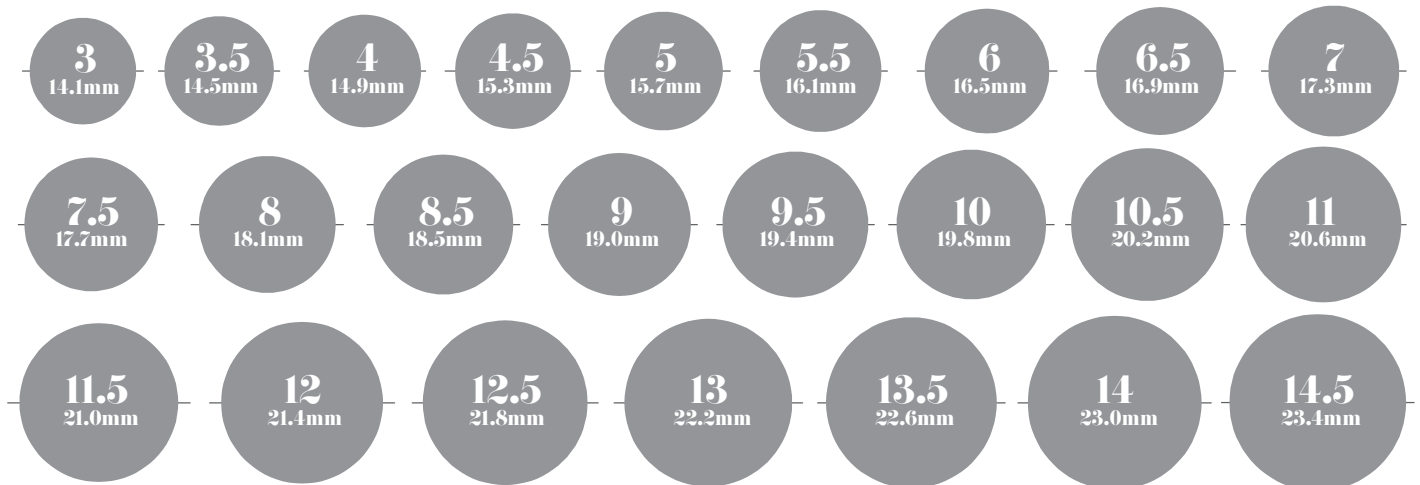

## HOW TO FIND YOUR FINGER SIZE?



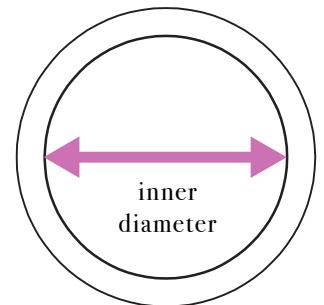
1. Before printing this guide, make sure the page is set to 100% (letter size) in your print settings.
2. Once printed, measure the bar on the left with a ruler to make sure it is 1 inch or 30 mm long. If the measurement is not accurate, check that you are printing it true size (100%) and reprint the page before continuing.

### OPTION 1: MEASURE WITH AN EXISTING RING



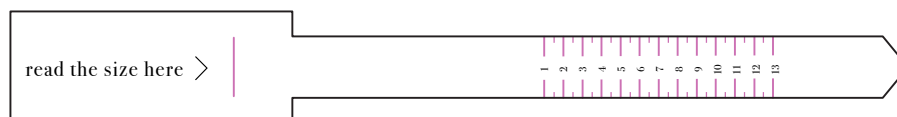
### OPTION 1 : MEASURE WITH AN EXISTING RING

1. Select a ring of the desired size.
2. Place the ring or band over the circles until you find the one that matches the inner edge of the ring.
3. The inner edge of your ring should line up with the outer edge of the circle.
4. If the ring is between two sizes, go for the larger of the two.



### OPTION 2 : MEASURE WITH THIS RULER

Carefully cut out the ruler below and cut the line to create a slot. Insert the tip of the ruler around the base of your finger and push the tapered end through the slit. This will give you your ring size. To make sure the ring fits comfortably, it's important to measure your knuckle. A good ring size should be easy to put on and take off.



**Note:** These tools are solutions to help you if you can't come in store to measure your size, but measurement errors are possible. We advise you to order our ring gauge or to visit us to get the right measurement.
