ASSEMBLY & INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Please Note: After installation extra hardware and accessories are possible; our kits are used on multiple products.


To Attach to Wall (Figure 1)

CAUTION: BE SURE POWER IS OFF AT THE MAIN BREAKER BOX PRIOR TO INSTALLATION.

- 1. Carefully unpack the fixture (A) from the carton.
- Using two machine screws (not provided) attach mounting bracket (B) to the electrical box.
 Note: A new electric box comes with screws. When replacing a fixture, retain the existing screws for use with the new fixture.
- 3. Using the green ground screw (C) and the cupped washer (D) found in the kit bag secure a pigtail lead to the mounting bracket (B). Hold the fixture (A) close to the mounting bracket (B) and using suitable wire connectors (not provided), connect fixture wires to supply wire (white to white and black to black). Connect all ground wires (bare copper or green to bare copper or green).

CAUTION: MAKE SURE WIRE CONNECTORS ARE TWISTED ON SECURELY, AND NO BARE WIRES ARE EXPOSED.

- 4. Carefully tuck all wires behind fixture (A) and inside the mounting bracket (B). Place fixture (A) firmly onto bracket (B) and fasten with two #8 screws (E) on top.
- 5. Install the two remaining #8 screws (E) in bottom of fixture (A).






CONTINUED

To Install Glass (Figure 2)

- 1. Install bulb (not included)
- 2. Remove one thumb screw (G) from one of the brackets (F).
- 3. Allow the bracket (F) to swing to a vertical position. See Figure 2.
- 4. Holding the glass (H) horizontal, place the neck of the glass against the bracket (F) that is completely installed.
- 5. In one movement, rotate the glass (H) to a vertical position while swinging the bracket (F) back into a horizontal position.
- 6. Re-install the thumb screw (G) into the bracket (F).
- 7. Restore electricity at main breaker.
