# **Assembly & Installation Instructions**

Portico Outdoor Pendant with Drum 362010



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**CAUTION:** FAILURE TO INSTALL THIS FIXTURE PROPERLY MAY RESULT IN SERIOUS PERSONAL INJURY OR DEATH AND PROPERTY DAMAGE. We recommend installation by a licensed electrician.

This product must be installed in accordance with applicable installation code(s), by a person familiar with the construction and operation of the product and the hazards involved.\*

Caution: Do not exceed maximum wattage noted on fixture. Use only recommended bulbs with fixture.

**Caution:** Damp location outdoor hanging fixtures are designed for use in covered spaces such as porches protected from prolonged exposure to water and wind. If installing in locations subject to wind the use of supplementary chains, cables, or similar restraints may be necessary to protect against swinging and twisting. If in doubt consult a qualified installer.

**Please Note:** After installation extra hardware and accessories are possible due to our kits are used on multiple products and options.

### To Install Fixture (Figures 1 & 2)

### Component Parts

G Knurled Ball (2)


A Fixture Coupling H Canopy Pipe
B Fixture Pipe I Clutch
C Canopy J Set Screw (3)
D Crossbar K Safety Cable
E Ground Screw L Safety Cable
F Threaded Stud (2) Screw

# Caution: Be sure power is off at the main breaker box prior to installation.

- 1. Carefully unpack the fixture from the carton. Locate fixture pipe (B) and slip over wires.
- 2. Apply a drop of the supplied thread locking compound to the internal threads of the fixture coupling (A) and screw fixture pipe (B) into fixture coupling (A), being careful not to twist the wires.

**Note:** Application of the thread locking compound is necessary to prevent the stem from loosening during regular maintenance and cleaning of the fixture. Be certain to apply the compound.

- 3. Slide the wires from the fixture pipe (B) through the canopy pipe (H) and up through the canopy (C).
- 4. Slide the canopy pipe (H) over the fixture pipe (B) as far as necessary to give you the total length of the fixture which you desire. Be careful not to scratch the pipe surface and to pull excess wire up through the canopy pipe (H). There must be a minimum 1-1/2" of inner pipe inside the outer pipe.
- 5. Tighten the three set screws (J) in clutch (I) firmly with hex wrench provided. Be sure to tighten evenly so that fixture pipe (B) stays centered in clutch (I).

6. Thread studs (F) through appropriate holes in crossbar (D) to match holes in canopy (C).




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  - 7. Using two machine screws (not provided), fasten the crossbar (D) to the electric box. Figure 2

    Note: A new electric box comes with screws. When replacing a fixture, retain the existing screws for use with the new fixture.
  - 8. Hold fixture close to ceiling. Attach safety cable (K) to crossbar (D) using safety cable screw (L). Safety cable (K) is used to temporarily support fixture while making wiring connections.
  - 9. Using suitable wire connectors (not provided) connect fixture wires to supply (white to white and black to black). Attach a pigrail lead to the crossbar ground screw (E). Connect all ground wires (bare copper or green to bare copper or green). Caution:

    Make sure wire connectors are twisted on securely, and no bare wire is exposed.
  - 10. Slide canopy (C) over threaded studs (F) and push firmly to ceiling, making sure that no wires are pinched between fixture canopy and ceiling. Fasten with knurled balls (G). Be sure studs are fully seated in the knurled balls.
  - 11. Refer to instructions following to install glass.






## To Install Glass (Figure 3 & 4)

#### Component Parts

- M Socket (5)
- N Fixture Cup (5)
- O Glass (5)
- P O-Ring (10)
- 1. Install bulbs (not provided) into socket (M). (Figure 4)
- 2. Slide two o-rings (P) onto the open end of glass (O). (*Figure 3*) Note: Slide first o-ring onto glass roughly one inch and the second can be close to the edge of the glass.
- 3. Repeat for remaining glass (O).
- 4. Slide glass (O) over bulb and into fixture cup (N). (Figure 4)
- 5. Continue to press glass (O) into fixture cup (N) until both o-rings (P) are inside of fixture cup (N) and glass (O) has bottomed out in the cup (N).
- 6. Repeat for remaining glass (O).
- 7. Restore electricity at main breaker.
