



Install the Fixture



- I Secure the mounting plate to the junction box.
- 2 Determine the wanted height or look of the fixture with the provided stems and assemble them by screwing them together.
- 3 Feed the fixture wires through the stem assembly, then screw the stem assembly onto the socket assembly.
- 4 Feed the fixture wires through the hang straight and canopy, then screw the hang straight onto the stem assembly.
- 5 Connect the fixture to a suitable ground in accordance to local electrical codes.
- 6 Connect the white fixture wire (square and/or rigid) to the neutral power line wire with a wire nut.
- 7 Connect the black fixture wire (round and/or smooth) to the hot power line wire with a wire nut.
- 8 Neatly place all the wires into the junction box, place the canopy onto the mounting studs, and secure it in place by screwing the cap nuts onto the mounting studs.
- 9 Screw the lamp into the socket. Refer to the label on the socket for Max Wattage Information.
- Place the shade into the bracket and secure in place using the thumb screws.
