


- 1 Thread the wire 3x18 AWG cord through finger nut, canopy threaded stem with nut and star-washer
- 2 Adjust the length of the cord and tie a knot to relief
- 3 Connect in junction-box
- 4 Screw on the cross-bar
- 5 Adjust the nuts on the stem and tighten
- 6 Put on the star-washer and the canopy and finally tighten finger nut

Recommended cleaning substances:

Wipe off dust with a dry, soft cloth. Remove greasy spots etc. with a soft cloth dampened in lukewarm water ($<122^{\circ}$ F/ 50° C) with a mild detergent.

Never use detergents containing abrasives and solvents.

Glossy lacquered surfaces in specific:

The glossy lacquered surfaces should be maintained with a suitable polish in order to prevent deterioration and drying. The polish agent may not contain any sort of abrasives. The polish must be applied according to the supplier's instructions using a very soft cloth (microfiber). Note: Avoid any contact between the polish and the matt lacquered surfaces of the product.


Warning: Scouring powder and similar substances will scratch surfaces.
