Dear Dr. Moschik:

This letter is in response to your request for approval of the ISSE Safety device in the state of Washington under Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 204-24-035.

The information provided was reviewed by a committee which included members from the Washington State Patrol and the Washington State Department of Transportation. After review of all of the information presented, the recommendations by the committee was to:

- 1. Approve the ISSE PD as an alternative traction tire device for both front and rear wheel drive vehicles.
- 2. Approve the ISSE Truck as an alternative traction tire device for use on vehicles or vehicle combinations over 10,000 pounds with five or less axles.

Please note the rules adopted by WSP pertain to use on roadways where vehicle travel is restricted by the Washington State Department of Transportation. In the state of Washington this typically pertains to the mountain passes. Therefore, these determinations in no way restrict the use of the alternative traction devices on other roadways of the state when conditions may warrant use of a traction device.

Please ensure that your customers understand that the use of ISSE Truck for vehicles or vehicle combinations over 10,000 pounds is restricted to vehicles having five axles or less and used in accordance with the manufacturers recommendations.
