MAKE YOUR OWN AEROPLANE

You will need:

- · 3 wooden sticks
- 1 clothes peg
- · foam sheet


Colour in the wooden sticks any colour you like. I have chosen red and blue!

Once the felt tips have dried, place the peg on its side and glue one of the wooden sticks on the top and one wooden stick on the bottom. Make sure you haven't glued them too close the end of the peg, they should be just off the centre.

Cut the third wooden stick in half. Glue this to the opposite end of the pegs — this is the back of the aeroplane.

Cut a small right angle out of the foam sheet and glue this in the middle of the smaller wooden stick – this is the back of the aeroplane.

You are now ready to fly your plane!



MAKE YOUR OWN BUTTERFLY

You will need:

• 1 wooden peg

• Pipe cleaner

· 2 googly eyes

Coloured card

• Felt tip pen

• Glue

Ensure your peg is upside down (this is the butterfly's body) and stick 2 googly eyes near the top of the peg.

Cut the pipe cleaner so you are left with approx. 3cm of it. Cut this in half again and using glue, stick to the top of the wooden peg, this is your butterfly's antennae.

Draw a pair of butterfly wings, you can do them as big as you want but I have drawn mine approximately 8cm wide. Decorate the wings however you want. I have gone for a simple design of blue polka dots.







Glue the wooden peg to the centre of the wings you have drawn and watch your butterfly come to life.



GIRAFFE FINGER PUPPET

You will need:

- Yellow card
- White card
- · Googly eyes
- Scissors
- Glue
- Black felt tip pen
- · Brown felt tip pen

Cut out a circle from the yellow card. At the lower end of the circle cut two small circles — this is where your fingers will go so make sure you make them big enough for your fingers to fit comfortably.

Cut out a rectangle from the yellow card and stick it to the middle of the circle — this is your giraffe's neck.

Cut out another circle and two small triangles for the giraffe's face and ears. Glue the ears to its head, and its head to its neck – you should be able to see your giraffe slowly coming together.

Using the white card, draw and cut out two tentacles and stick them between the giraffe's ears. Stick down two googly eyes and draw a nose and a mouth using the black felt tip.

Your giraffe is now ready to star in its own puppet show.

MAKE YOUR OWN BRACELET

You will need:

- String
- Beads
- Scissors

Choose one of the coloured strings and measure it around your wrist so your bracelet will fit perfectly.

TOP TIP: make the bracelet slightly bigger than your wrist so you can make sure you can fit the beads on.

Select what beads you want and slide the string through them. When you have done this tie a knot in the string, so no beads fall off.

Why not make a necklace to match? Just make the string longer.

MONSTER BOOKMARK

You will need:

- lolly stick
- Pom poms
- Pipe cleaners
- · Googly eyes



Pick a lolly stick and colour it in your favourite colour. To make it super cool then why not draw different patterns on it like stripes or dots.

Choose a pom-pom and with the glue, stick it to the top of the lolly pop stick.

Add googly eyes to the pom-pom. The choice is up to you how many eyes you want to add, the weirder the better!

Cut the pipe cleaners into small pieces and use them as the ears for your monster. Stick them to the pom-pom with glue.

You can make a whole family of monsters. Try to make each one different, why not glue a few sticks together for a wider body or creating one with 2 heads?!

MAKE YOUR OWN MONSTER



You will need:

- lolly sticks
- Scissors
- Tape
- · Googly eyes
- Craft glue
- Felt tip pens
- Paper

STICKER BOARDS

You will need:

- Stickers
- Boards
- An imagination

You have the choice of an underwater board or a space one.

Why not try both and see which one you prefer!

Use the underwater stickers to create a scene you'd see at the bottom of the ocean.

Use the space stickers to imagine what it could be like up in space.

If you're feeling extra creative, then why not stick the astronaut under water?

This is the time to REALLY use your imagination!

Once complete you can always peel them off and start again...

SUPERHERO STICKS

You will need:

- · Wooden sticks
- felt tip pens
- Coloured paper

Draw a colourful design on one side of the stick (this is your superhero's body) – We have done different coloured stripes.

Cut a small rectangle, approximately 1.5cm wide, draw two eyes on it and glue it near the top of the stick. This is your superhero's mask.

Draw a big smile underneath the mask so your superhero is happy.

Now for the cape.

Cut out a triangle shape, approximately 10cm wide and glue the stick to the centre of the triangle. Decorate the cape however you want. You could colour it in one colour or draw stripes or even a polka dot pattern.

Your superhero is now ready to fight crime!

TISSUE PAPER COLLAGES

You will need:

- Black pencil
- Card
- Tissue paper
- Glue

Using your black pencil, draw an image on your chosen card, I have gone with a rainbow as I want mine to be bright and colourful.

Other ideas you may want to try could be a flower, a star, a heart or even your favourite animal?

Tear the tissue paper into several pieces, scrunch it up, apply some glue on one side and stick it to the card.

Press down on the scrunched-up tissue paper to make sure it really sticks to the card.

Repeat this using different coloured tissue paper to create your image.

TOP TIP: Tear off different sized pieces and scrunch them for a really cool effect.

MAKE YOUR OWN PAPER BUTTERFLY DECORATIONS

You will need:

- Paper
- Scissors
- Pipe Cleaners


Cut the paper depending on what size butterfly you want to make. Fold the paper in half and then cut along the fold.

Take one piece and fold in half and then fold the corners in. Fold one side upwards and then forwards and backwards again. Repeat on the other side.

Then fold the other paper like demonstrated in the video below. Tie the pieces together using a pipe cleaner.

You can hang your butterfly in your room or tie it to a keyring.

You can create several different colour butterflies with the supplied craft kit.



TISSUE PAPER FLOWERS

You will need:

- Tissue paper
- Coloured card
- Glue

Pick one piece of coloured card for the background of your creation.

Cut a long piece of green card for the stalk of the flower. Cut out leaf shapes and glue these to the card.

Draw the centre of your flower and the petals with a pencil as a guide of where to stick the tissue paper.

Using different coloured pieces of tissue tear them up and scrunch it into a ball.

Stick it down using the glue. Carry on with this method until you have completed the flower.

Rub out any pencil marks you may be able to see.

Create a variety of flower shapes with different colours.



UNICORN STICKS

You will need:

- · Wooden stick
- Coloured paper
- Scissors
- Glue
- Pink and black felt tip pens
- Gem stickers



Draw around the wooden stick on a piece of coloured paper and cut it out.

Wrap the paper you have cut out around the wooden stick and glue it to keep it secure — this is the unicorn's body.

Draw a circle and two small triangles on the coloured paper and cut them out. The two triangles are the unicorn's ears, glue them to the top of the circle and draw smaller triangles in the ears in pink.

With the black felt tip draw the unicorn's eyes and add some small circles in pink for its rosy cheeks.

Glue the unicorn's head to the top of the wooden stick — you will now see your unicorn slowly coming together.

Draw a slightly bigger triangle than before on a piece of yellow paper or card and cut it out. Glue it between the unicorn's ears – this is the unicorn's horn.

Finish off by decorating your unicorn with different coloured gem stickers.

You can use your unicorn as a pretty decoration or as a bookmark.

WOODEN STICK SNAKE CRAFT

You will need:

- 5 sticks
- · Google eyes
- Felt tips
- Coloured card
- Glue

Design a colourful pattern on 4 of the wooden sticks. These can be any pattern you want. To make it really cool make sure each stick is a different pattern — you could do stripes, spots or zigzags.

After the felt tips have dried, glue one end of the stick to another end of the stick so the sticks are in a zig zag shape — this is the snake's body.

With the fifth stick cut each end of the stick so it is approximately 3cm long then glue the sides together — this is the snakes face. This will then need to be glued to the end of the snake's body.

Place the googly eyes on the snake's face and draw a nose with a black felt tip.

The final part is the snake's tongue. Draw a snake's tongue on coloured card of your choice and glue to the snake's face.


You can make a family for the snake but with different sized bodies by cutting the sticks smaller and colouring them in in different colours.







UNICORN BOOKMARK



You will need:

- Coloured card
- Scissors
- Coloured [pencils
- Craft glue
- Felt tip pens

Also included:

- COLOURING BOOK
- DOT TO DOT BOOK
- WORD SEARCH BOOK

These are great for when on the move and have a spare few minutes.

These A5 books always come in handy.

Can be used in conjunction with the supplied felt tip pens and coloured pencils.
