

CHLORINATING YOUR WATER LINES

If a smell or odor is in your water

You will need: 1-3 gal. Household bleach (non scented)

1. Turn off your water and water heater, unscrew your canister, and remove the filter
2. Empty the water from the canister
3. Fill canister with bleach
4. Replace the canister
5. Turn the water on slowly watch for leaks
6. Go into your home and to the faucet furthest from the inlet water, turn on a hot water faucet run until you smell bleach then shut faucet.
7. Turn the cold water on until you smell bleach then shut faucet.
8. Now go throughout the house and open every faucet until you smell bleach, this includes washing machines and dishwashers, outside hose bibs
9. If you do not smell bleach at a faucet add more to the canister and continue the process.

Let the bleach stay in the lines for a few hours, then you can replace the filter and run a faucet until the bleach smell is gone, run the washing machine without any clothes to remove all bleach to protect your clothing, same with your dishwasher.
