CHLORINATING YOUR WATER LINES

If a smell or odor is in your water

You will need: 1-3 gal. Household bleach (non scented)

- 1. Turn off your water and water heater, unscrew your canister, and remove the filter
- 2. Empty the water from the canister
- 3. Fill canister with bleach
- 4. Replace the canister
- 5. Turn the water on slowly watch for leaks
- 6. Go into your home and to the faucet furthest from the inlet water, turn on a hot water faucet run until you smell bleach then shut faucet.
- 7. Turn the cold water on until you smell bleach then shut faucet.
- 8. Now go throughout the house and open every faucet until you smell bleach, this includes washing machines and dishwashers, outside hose bibs
- 9. If you do not smell bleach at a faucet add more to the canister and continue the process.

Let the bleach stay in the lines for a few hours, then you can replace the filter and run a faucet until the bleach smell is gone, run the washing machine without any clothes to remove all bleach to protect your clothing, same with your dishwasher.
