



WARNING: When using Sloggn Base Deck and accessories, the user must understand the precautions. The points listed below will assist you in using the rack system and will encourage safety.

- For quality fits and safety, use only the recommended Sloggn Gear rack or accessories.
- The maximum load specified in the assembly instructions is not to be exceeded. However, this limit is always subordinate to the maximum load recommended by the manufacturer of the car itself. It is always the lower maximum recommended load that applies. Max load = load carrier weight + any fitted carrier accessories + the weight of the load itself.
- Make sure all knobs, bolts, screws, straps, and locks are firmly attached, tightened, and locked before every trip. Knobs, bolts, screws, straps, and locks must be periodically inspected for signs of wear, corrosion, and fatigue. Check your gear at stops during the trip to ensure continued fastening security.
- Check local and state laws governing the projection of objects beyond the perimeter of a vehicle. Be aware of the width, length, and height of your cargo since low clearance branches, bridges, and parking garages can affect the load. All cargo will affect the vehicle's driving behavior. Never drive with any lock, knob, or rack in an open or unlocked position.

- Remove your Sloggn rack and accessories when they are not in use and before entering automatic car washes.
- For the safety of your vehicle and rack system, obey all posted speed limits and traffic cautions. Adapt your speed to the conditions of the road and the load being carried.
- Do not use Sloggn Gear and accessories for purposes other than those for which they were designed. Do not exceed their carrying capacity. Failure to follow these guidelines or the product's instructions will void the warranty.
- All loads must be secured using the provided hardware.
- Use of the carrier is restricted to Class II (and higher), 2" or 1 1/4" receiver hitch.
- Do not allow people to climb, get into, or sit on the carrier at any time.
- Do not use this carrier for transporting people, animals, or flammables.
- Not for off-road use.
- Vehicle taillights must remain visible.
- Contact customer service if you have any questions regarding the operations and limits of Sloggn products. Review all instructions and warranty information carefully.

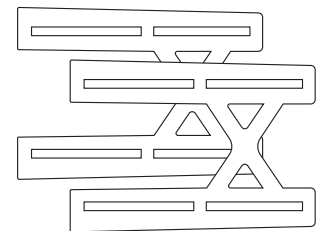

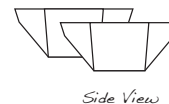


(2) Cross Bars

(2) Slide Plates



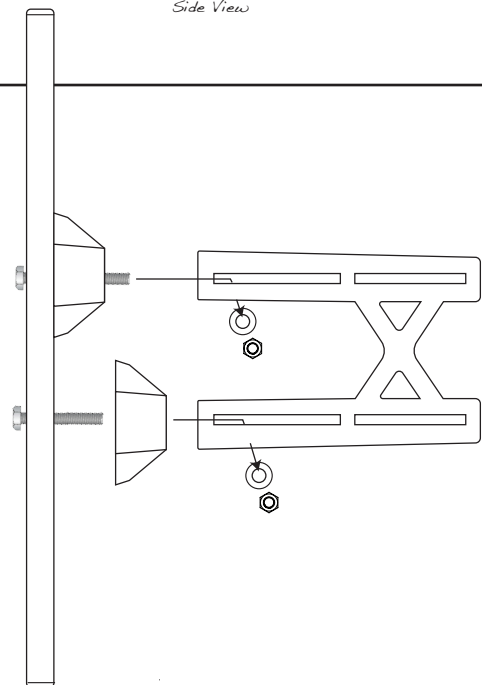

1 Assembling the Roof-2-Hitch Bracket:

Step one is to assemble the Roof-2-Hitch Bracket.

- Insert 3" bolt through one of the inside hole of the cross bar, side broad end of Riser onto 3" bolt first.
- Repeat on other inside hole.
- Slide assembled Cross Bar, Bolt and Riser onto end of Slide Plate.
- Add washer and nylon washer. Tighten with assembly slide away to end
- Repeat on other side.



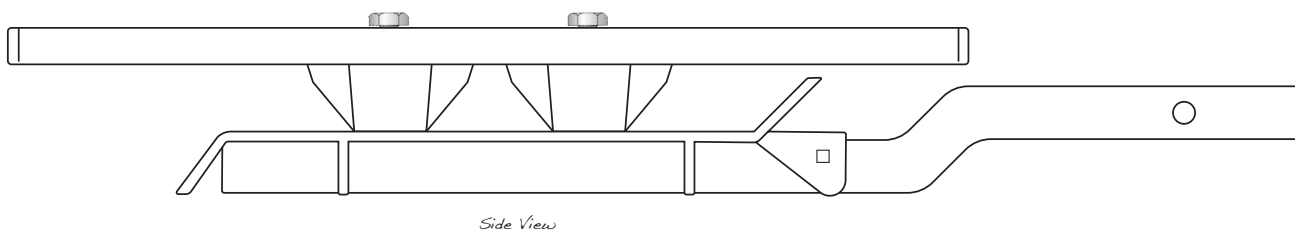
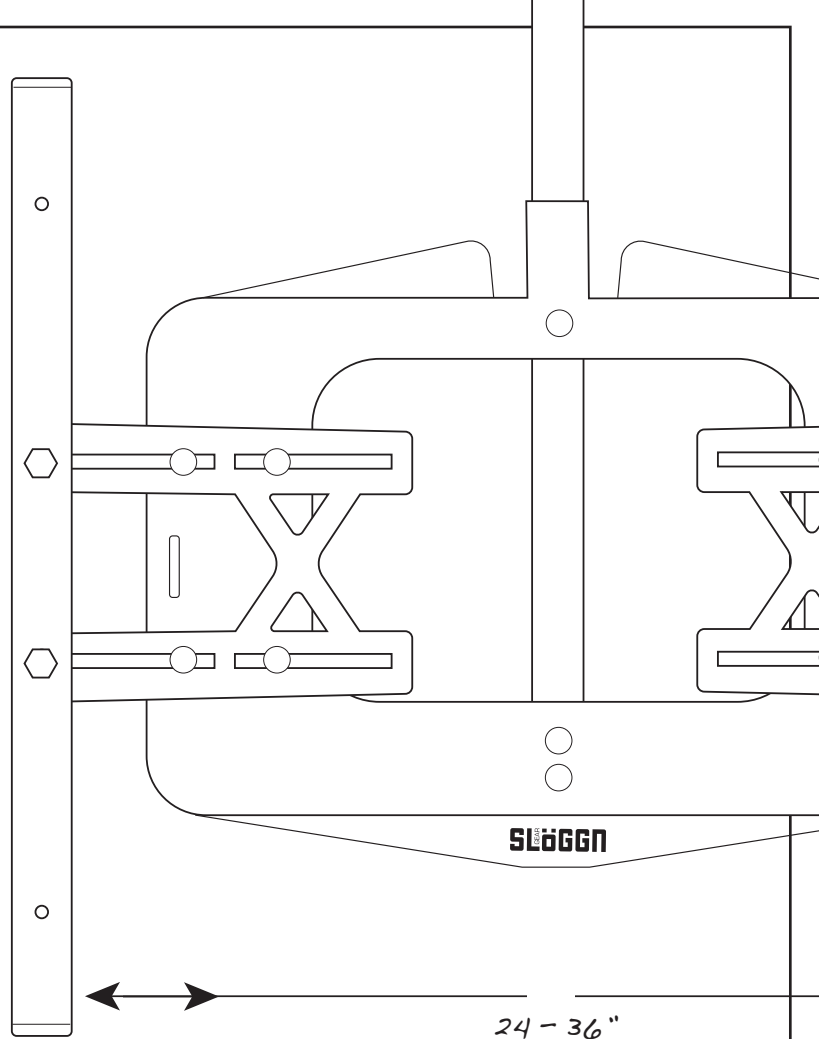
2 Mount Roof-2-Hitch Bracket to Base Deck:

With both Roof-2-Hitch Brackets mounted to the Slide Plate you will add the assembly to the Base Deck.

- Hand tighten the 4 .75 inch bolts, slide bolt through Slide Plate, Base Deck and then add washer and nylon nut.
- Repeat on other side.
- The Roof-2-Hitch Bracket can now be slide back and forth to meet your desired width.

3 Attaching Accessories:

With the Roof-2-Hitch assembled, you can follow the instructions of your manufactures accessory (bike rack, ski rack, recovery boards, etc) for mounting to standard roof crossbars.
