Polished Brass (PB)

Durability



A warm accent

- A classic polished and lacquered finish.
- Finish will age and tarnish over time, developing a unique character.



Antique Brass (AB)

Durability



Earthy undertones

Durability



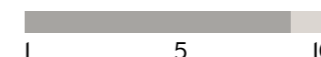
Sleek and adaptable

Rumbled Nickel (RN)

- Nickel-plating is aged before each product is 'rumbled' with small stones to reveal glimpses of the nickel through the antique finish.



Polished Nickel (PN)

- A highly durable finish that is warmer than chrome.
- Highly polished nickel-plate gives this finish its beautiful depth of colour.
- Regular cleaning will maintain the lustre of this finish.



Satin Nickel (SN)

Understated and chic

- Soft to the touch and exhibiting warm hues.
- To achieve this finish, nickel-plated forged brass is very lightly finished, before being plated with satin nickel.





..... **Euro Set:** High security locks used on external doors





..... **Lever on Rose Euro Set:** High security locks used on external doors





..... **Privacy Set:** Ideal for bathrooms, they have a thumb turn for privacy






