**Placement and Maintenance**

Your Perle Table is designed for indoor use on level floors. Furniture with hard lacquer, wax polish or painted surface should be dusted with a dry cloth. Spillages should be wiped up as soon as possible. Our furniture will endure most temperatures in the home but it is best to avoid placing furniture next to heat sources such as radiators or fires.

**Step 1**

Unpack and identify all the parts listed here. It is necessary to have **two people to carry and assemble** units weighing over 50 lbs. 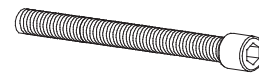
**T1 Wrench (M13) x 1**



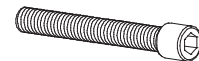
**T2 M6 Allen Key x 1**



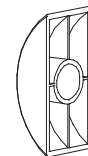
**H1 Headless Bolt (8x110mm) x 4**

**H3 Bolt (8x60mm) x 8**



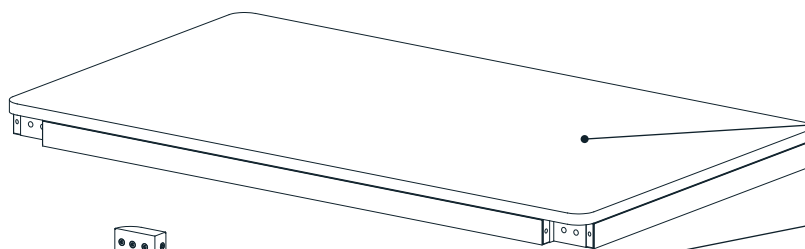
**H4 Fixing Head x 8**

**H6 Washer x 8**



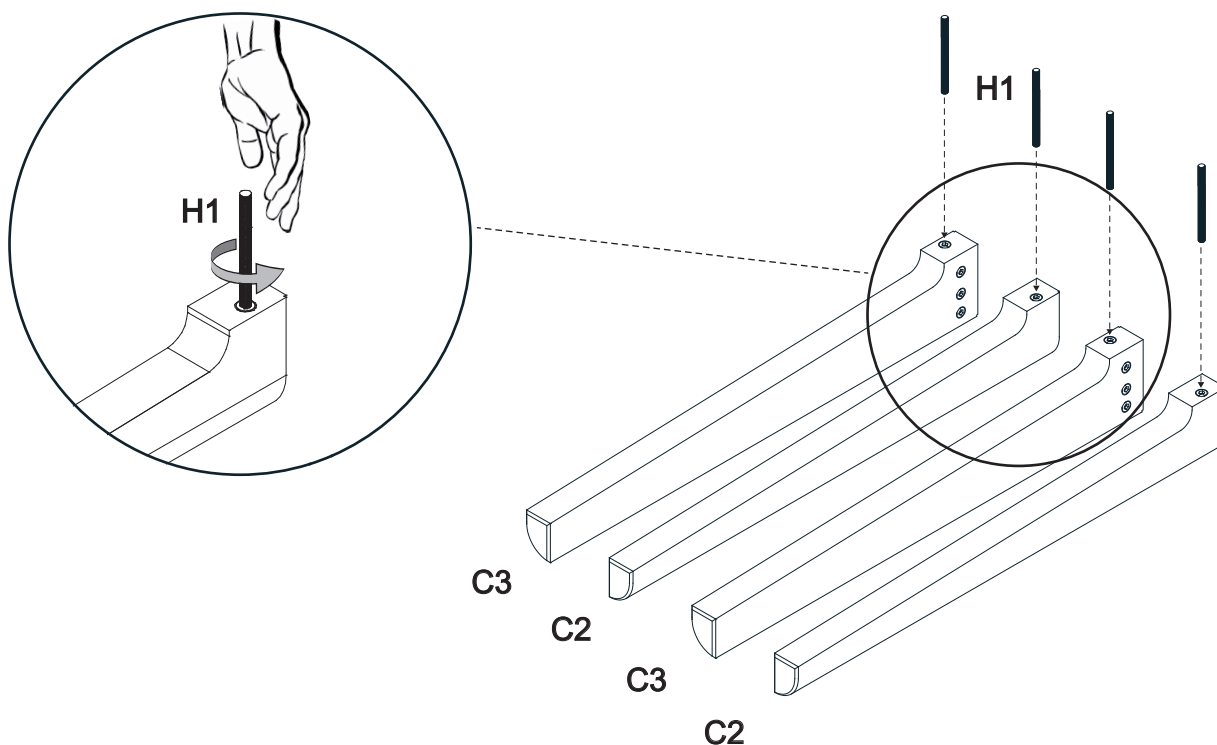
**C1 Table Top x 1**

**C3 Leg B x 2**

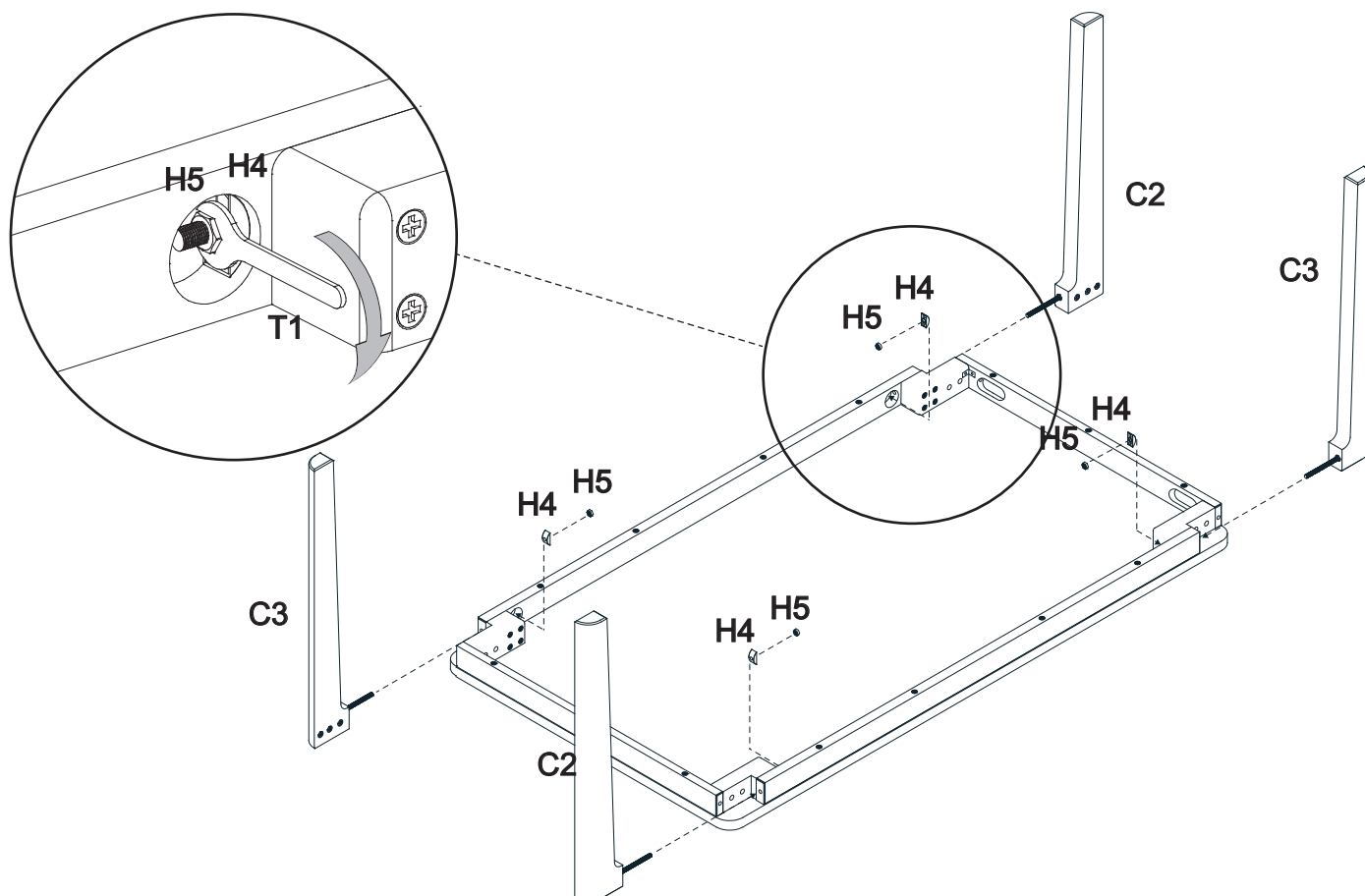
## Step 2 - Fix the headless bolt to legs.

Fix 4 headless bolts H1 to the legs C2, C3 by hand.



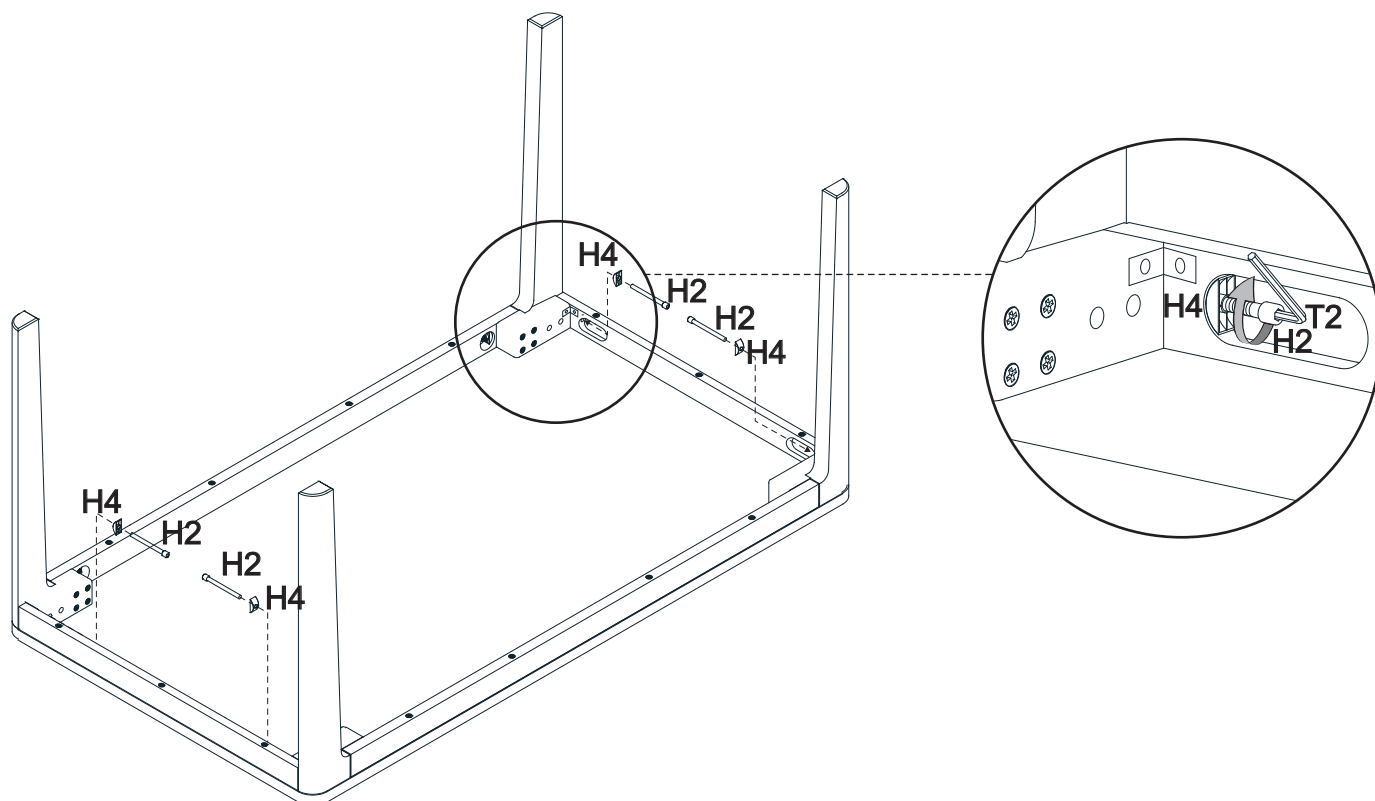
## Step 3 - Attach legs to top module

Place 4 fixing heads H4 into the slots on the bottom rails. Attach the legs C2, C3 to the top module C1 as shown below. Then fix the 4 hex nuts H5 by using the wrench T1.



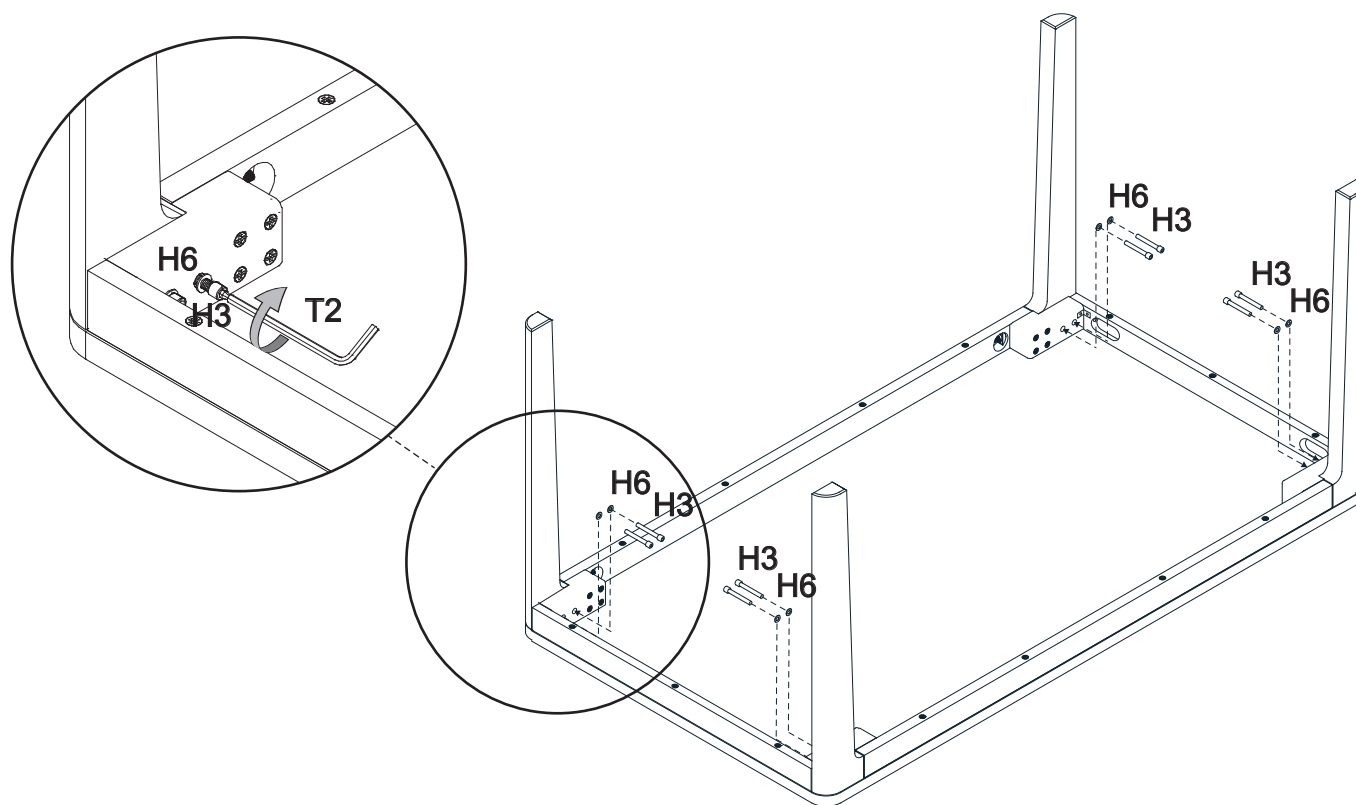
#### Step 4 - Fix additional bolts.

Use **4 bolts H2** and **4 fixing heads H4** for additional support.



#### Step 5 - Fix the legs by using bolts.

Use **8 bolts H3** and **8 washers H6** to fix the legs onto the table top.



## Step 6 - End of the assembly.

Lift the unit to standing position carefully.
