



Tips, Tricks and Information for Light Transfer Paper

- Make sure to mirror your image before printing onto NuFun Light Transfer Paper.
- Light Transfer Paper is compatible with all INKJET Printers. You must use an INKJET printer.
- Any excess paper around your image that is transferred onto your fabric shows up as transparent, meaning that you do not need to cut perfectly around your image.
- Peel the image from your fabric while still hot - this will allow the resin to penetrate into the fabric rather than adhering back to the backing paper.
- To ensure quality, make sure to turn your garment inside out and wash in cold water after the transfer is complete.
- When ironing an image with Light Transfer Paper to a pre-stretched canvas, make sure to have an object such as a pillow to fill the void in the back of the canvas while applying heat. If not done, the image may not transfer evenly in all areas due to lack of pressure and heat.
