MIAMI

FINE ART AUCTIONS MIAMI

BASE SUPERSTORE

After nearly 25 years in South Beach, Base made the move to Wynwood early this year. The concept store maintains a rotating inventory of items you never knew you needed, like an Andy Warhol-inspired plush toy from Kid Robot or a miniature gold Lomography camera. You'll also find streetwear staples from Nanamica, Neuw Denim, and Stampd, plus a signature line of scents that takes its cue from the city itself, with fragrances like Sand and Sea. baseworld.com.
