
Antique Tile Block

Unfinished Block Size: 6-1/2" x 6-1/2"

Fabric A

(1) 1-1/2" x 6" strip

(4) 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles

Fabric B

(1) 2-1/2" x 2-1/2"

(1) 1-1/2" x 6" strip

(1) 1-1/2" x 10" strip

Fabric C

(1) 1-1/2" x 10" strip

Sewing Instructions Making the strip set

- 1. Place one 1-1/2" x 10" strip of fabric B and C right sides together (RST).
- 2. Sew a scant 1/4" seam on one of the 10" long edges. Open and iron to the dark side.
- 3. Cut the strip set into four 2-1/2" squares.

Creating Block A/B

- 1. Place one 1-1/2" x 6" strip of fabric A and B RST.
- 2. Sew a scant 1/4" seam on one of the 6" long edges. Open and iron to the dark side.
- 3. Cut the strip set into four 1-1/2" by 2-1/2" rectangles.


Sewing the Blocks

1. Take one 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangle of fabric A and place it RST with an A/B block, sew together and repeat on the remaining rectangles.

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Assembling the block

1. Arrange the blocks as depicted. Sew into rows, press as desired then sew the rows together. Unfinished size should measure approximately 6-1-2".



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
