## Fabric A

(2) $3^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$
(1) $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime}$ strip

## Fabric B

(1) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
(2) $3^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$
(1) $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime}$ strip

Unfinished Block Size: 12-1/2" x 12-1/2"

## Fabric A

(2) $5^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$
(1) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 18-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip

## Fabric B

(1) $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
(2) $5^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$
(1) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 18-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip

## Sewing Instructions

## Making the HST's

1. Place one 3 " fabric $A$ and $B$ square right sides together. Draw a diagonal line from the top right to the bottom left.
2. Sew a scant $1 / 4$ inch away from either side of the line. Iron the block, then cut it in half on the line you drew to create 2 HST 's.
3. Repeat on the remaining 3 " squares of fabric to create four blocks. Trim to 2-1/2" square and press as desired.

## Making the strip set

1. Place one $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime}$ strip of fabric $A$ and $B$ right sides together.
2. Sew a scant $1 / 4$ " seam on one long edge. Open and iron to the dark side
3. Cut the strip set into four 2$1 / 2$ " squares.


## Assembling the block

1. Arrange the blocks as depicted. Sew into rows, press as desired then sew the rows together. Unfinished size should measure
 approximately 6-1-2".
