




Unfinished Block Size: 8.5" x 8.5"



For this block it is recomended fabric C be a background or blender fabric.

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Sewing Instructions

- 1. Arrange your squares so the print squares are on opposite corner. Sew together into two rows. Press to the dark side.
- 2. Sew the rows together to make one block. Iron seam open.
- With right side facing up, cut the block 1 inch from each sewn center seam. This should create 9 block pieces.

Variation A

- Rotate the left center and right center piece 180 degrees.
 Rotate the top middle, and bottom middle piece 180 degrees.
- 2. Rotate the middle center piece 180 degrees.
- 3. Sew the rows together and press the seams open.
- 4. Trim the block to 8-1/2" square.

Variation **B**

- Swap the left center and right center piece, then swap the top middle, and bottom middle piece.
- 2. Sew the rows together and press the seams open.
- 3. Trim the block to 8-1/2" square.
