Unfinished Block Size: 12" x 12"
Fabric A
(2) $5^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$

## Fabric B

(10) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## Fabric C

(2) $5^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$
(10) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## Sewing Instructions

Making the HST's

1. Place one 5" Fabric A and C square good sides together. Draw a diagonal line from the top right to the bottom left.
2. Sew a scant $1 / 4$ inch away from either side of the line. Iron the block, then cut it in half on the line you drew to create 2 HST's.
3. Repeat on the remaining $5^{\prime \prime}$ squares of Fabric to create four blocks. Trim to 4-1/2" square and press as desired.

## Making the 4 Patch Blocks

1. Arrange two $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares of fabric $B$ and two $2 / 1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares of fabric $C$ as depicted.
2. Sew the squares together into
 rows. Press to the dark fabric then sew the rows together.
3. Repeat on the remaining $2-1 / 2$ squares of fabric to create five blocks. Trim to 4-1/2" square.


## Assembling the block

1. Arrange the four HST's and five 4 Patch blocks as depicted. Sew into rows, press as desired then sew the rows together. Trim to 12 " square.
