


## Flying Geese

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## **Sewing Instructions**

- 1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each of the Fabric B pieces. With RST, place two fabric B squares on the fabric A square (**Fig. 1**). Pin and sew a scant 1/4 inch from either side of the line, then cut on the line you drew. (**Fig. 2**) Press seams to fabric B.
- 2. Place one fabric B piece RST on the block as shown in **Fig. 3**. Sew a scant 1/4 inch from either side of the line. Then cut apart on the line you drew. (**Fig. 4**) Press seam to fabric B.
- 3. Repeat step 2 on the remaining piece. Press the 4 completed geese toward fabric B. Trim the ears on all 4 pieces and your flying geese are complete.
