Unfinished Block Size: 15 " $\times 15$ "

## Fabric A

(4) $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ (Background)
(2) $6 \frac{112 "}{}{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 6 \frac{112 " \prime}{\prime \prime}$ (OST)

## Fabric B

(2) $6 \frac{112 " ~}{\prime \prime} \times 6^{1 ⁄ 2 \prime \prime}$ (QST)
(1) $5^{1 / 2 "} \times 5^{1 / 2 "}$ " (Centre piece)

## Making the HST (Half Square Triangles)

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of all (2) Fabric A - $6 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Place a Fabric A $61 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ square right sides together on a Fabric B $61 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ square.
2. Sew a $1 / 4$ " seam on each side of the line then cut on the line. Press to the dark side then trim blocks to 6 " square.
3. Repeat with the remaining $6 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ squares.


## Making the OST (Quarter Square triangles)

1. Place two HST right sides together with the diagonal lines parallel and opposing colors touching. (Fabric A should face Fabric B)
2. On the wrong side draw a diagonal line in the opposite direction of the existing seam. Sew a $1 / 4$ "seam on each side of the line then cut on the line. Press open then trim block to $5 \frac{1}{1} 2^{\prime \prime}$ square.
3. Repeat on the remaining HST pair.


## Assembling the block

1. Lay out the block pieces as shown below. Sew together one row at a time. Press seams to one side, or open. Stitch the rows together to make the block.
2. Trim to $15^{\prime \prime}$ square.
