CASABLANCA

IN THE OLD MEDINA (WALLED CITY), SHOPS ARE FILLED WITH LOCAL WARES - COLOURFUL SCARVES, DELICATELY BEADED MOROCCAN SLIPPERS, LEATHER BAGS AND POUFS WITH DECORATIVE DESIGNS, AND METAL LAMPS WITH ARABESQUE MOTIFS.

THE HASSAN II MOSQUE, WITH THE WORLD'S TALLEST MINARET, IS A BLEND OF ISLAMIC, MOORISH AND MOROCCAN ARCHITECTURAL STYLES. IT FEATURES HORSESHOE ARCHES, CEILINGS WITH ORNAMENTED VAULTS OF PAINTED WOOD AND SCULPTED PLASTER, CARVED MARBLE FOUNTAINS AND GRANITE COLUMNS. CAST BRONZE FINISHES AND ZELLIGE MOSAIC TILEWORK CAN BE FOUND ON THE EXTERIOR.






ESSAOUIRA

THIS SEASIDE TOWN IS NAMED FOR THE FORTRESS WALLS BUILT WHILE UNDER PORTUGUESE RULE. AS ONE OF THE MAJOR FISHING HARBOURS OF MOROCCO, THERE ARE BOATS APLENTY IN THE SCALA HARBOUR.

THE MEDIEVAL ARCHITECTURE HERE
IS A MIX OF EUROPEAN, ARAB AND
AFRICAN DESIGNS, WITH ARCHES
AND DOORS ADORNED BY TILES,
STONE CARVINGS AND METALWORK.

CRAFTSMEN SELL THEIR WARES IN THE MEDINA - WOOD SCULPTURES, SILVER JEWELLERY, COLOURFUL FAIENCE POTTERY, AND CERAMIC TAGINES SYNONYMOUS WITH MOROCCAN CUISINE. SEVERAL ARGAN OIL COOPERATIVES CAN BE FOUND OUTSIDE OF ESSAOUIRA.





MARRAKECH

AS MARRAKECH'S MAIN PLAZA, THE DJEMAA EL FNA SQAURE IS BUSY WITH HORSE-DRAWN CARRIAGES, VENDORS, SNAKE CHARMERS AND MONKEY TRAINERS. THE MARKET IS FULL OF ARTFULLY ARRANGED FRUITS, TEAPOTS, METAL LAMPS AND OTHER CRAFT PRODUCTS.

THE JARDIN MAJORELLE CONTAINS 300 PLANT SPECIES FROM 5 CONTINENTS IN FRENCH-DESIGNED GARDENS, AND AN ART DECO STUDIO IN VIBRANT COLOURS.

A GREAT EXAMPLE OF ISLAMIC ARCHITECTURE IS THE EL BAHIA ("BRILLIANCE") PALACE FROM THE LATE 19TH CENTURY. ITS ROOMS ARE DECORATED WITH PAINTED CEDARWOOD CEILINGS AND CARVED STUCCO DETAILS. ZELLIGE MOSAIC TILEWORK IS PROMINENT THROUGHOUT THE PALACE AND ITS COURTYARDS.



HIGH ATLAS MOUNTAINS

THIS IS THE HIGHEST MOUNTAIN RANGE IN AFRICA WITH PEAKS OVER 4000M. TERRACED FIELDS IN SHADES OF GREEN AND RUSSET, SHEPHERDS WITH FLOCKS OF SHEEP, ZIGZAG SWITCHBACK ROADS AND CLUSTERS OF CUBIC BERBER VILLAGES ARE COMMON SIGHTS.

A BERBER ADOBE HOME DISPLAYS MOROCCAN DESIGN FOR A FAMILY OF THREE GENERATIONS LIVING TOGETHER, ALONG WITH THEIR HOSPITALITY OF MOROCCAN MINT TEA.


OUARZAZATE TO ERG CHEBBI

WITH A TRANSITION IN LANDSCAPE,
OUARZAZATE IS KNOWN FOR ITS
UNESCO HERITAGE SITE - THE
KSAR OF AIT-BEN-HADDOU, MADE
UP OF EARTHEN TOWERS AND
DWELLING BLOCKS.

THE TODRA GORGE, LIMESTONE RIVER CANYONS WITH ROCK WALLS UP TO 160M, IS POPULAR WITH ROCK CLIMBERS. AT 1500M, BOUMALNE DU DADES IS A HILLSIDE TOWN AT THE EDGE OF THE DESERT PLATEAU.

ON THE WESTERN EDGE OF SAHARA
DESERT, THE ERG CHEBBI SAND
DUNES REACH HEIGHTS OF 150M,
SENSUAL DUNE PATTERNS FORMED
BY SHIFTING WINDS, BEDOUINS
WITH CAMEL CARAVANS, AND
MAGICAL SCENES AT SUNRISE AND
SUNSET ARE SIGHTS TO BEHOLD.

FES

THE MIDDLE ATLAS MOUNTAIN REGION HAS A MULTITUDE OF PATTERNED FIELDS. NORTHWEST OF THIS MOUNTAIN RANGE IS FES, THE CULTURAL HEART OF MOROCCO.

THE MEDINA OF FES, FULL OF NARROW CROWDED ALLEYWAYS, IS A WORLD HERITAGE SITE. BESIDES COLOURFUL SPICES AND FOODS IN THE MARKET, SKILLFUL CRAFTSMEN CAN BE SEEN IN THEIR SHOPS, SEWING LEATHER BAGS AND CAFTAN DRESSES, FORMING BRASS TEATRAYS AND KNIVES, WEAVING BERBER RUGS, PAINTING POTTERY AND CHISELLING MOSAIC TILES. WITH SOME OF THE WORLD'S OLDEST LEATHER TANNERIES, THEY ARE BUSY WITH WORKERS IN AND AROUND MULTIHUED VATS OF DYES.

CHEFCHAOUEN AND RABAT

FURTHER NORTH IN THE RIF MOUNTAINS IS CHEFCHAOUEN, THE BLUE PEARL OF MOROCCO. STAIRS, WALLS AND DOORS OF HOMES AND SHOPS ARE PAINTED IN VARIOUS SHADES OF BLUE, COMPLEMENTED BY COLOURFUL TILED THRESHOLDS AND FLOWERPOTS, PATTERNED AND VIBRANT GARMENTS. WINDOW FRAMES AND HANDRAILS ARE ORNAMENTED WITH WROUGHT IRON DETAILS, AND SPANISH INFLUENCE CAN BE SEEN IN OVERLAPPING ROOF TILES. ARCHES ARE A DOMINANT FEATURE, AND EVERY TURN IN THE STREET IS A PICTURE ON ITS OWN.

RABAT, THE CAPITAL CITY OF MOROCCO, ALSO HAS AN AREA OF BLUE-TONED BUILDINGS, ALONG WITH A CRESCENT-SHAPED BEACH.





















